violation. Hopefully, the problem gets corrected and that's the end of it;

- 2.) The RM sends out a little more stern 'second notice.' Once again, hopefully, the problem gets corrected and that's the end of it;
- 3.) Touchstone sends a third notice along with a fine TO THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY. At any point in this process, the owner or resident can appeal the notice to the Board.

If the Board upholds the infraction, the fine is deducted from their maintenance fee. To our knowledge, the warning is enforced across the Board. Children are not subject to fines, though their parents are held accountable.
