Two years ago in August, we hired a civil engineering firm to come out and give us an estimate on what it would cost to patch large parts of the project. We've had copies of the report on file in the office for 18 months. Thus far, only a couple of owners have looked at it.

The long and short of it is that patching and some re-grading will cost in excess of \$600,000. This year, we looked into alternate methods of paving ranging from permeable pavers to concrete to asphalt. The comparative prices were pretty close.

We've had Rich pave a sample parking area in permeable pavers at J1-2-3 (Next to 402). You can see a sample of our worst current paving right next to it (near 218).
