This family fun event will include historical reenactments and campsites, along with educational displays, learning opportunities for children and so much more. Admission is free, so we will attract folks to Bandera for a weekend of history, gunfights and old-fashioned fun at the Courthouse, while they stay to shop in Bandera!

And, it doesn’t stop when the sun goes down! The evening means you can head to Mansfield Park for the Ridin’ the River Cowboy Fellowship’s “Bulls, Barrels and Breakaway Rodeo” Free event, with gates opening at 7:00 pm. It’s all about keeping the Cowboy in The Cowboy Capital of the World!
