# Module 1. Olive Press Core Values. Matthew 5:3-10. Introduction

Setting the standard of Core Values is a pressing matter (pun intended). As you dive into Module 1, you will take a look at the Sermon on the Mount's Beatitudes in a way you may have never considered them before.

The Sermon on the Mount is often portrayed as a message delivered to a large crowd. And while there may have been many people present, Scripture tells us that Jesus called His disciples to Himself, sat down, and began to teach them these principles. This was paramount. This was intimate. This was for his closest disciples.

The Beatitudes are the way the Lord wants us to live our lives - and I would suggest that they are a launch pad to walking in the Fruit of the Spirit found in Galatians 5.

Take your time as you listen and read. Do the next step assignment, answer the questions.

Be ready to be transformed in the way you think and act as a follower of the Lamb of God.

Welcome to Module 1.



Blessed are: "Makarios" – supremely blessed, fortunate, well off, blessed and happy.

**Core value 1**. Blessed are those WHO ARE POOR IN SPIRIT for the kingdom of heaven belongs to them – verse 3.

"Poor in Spirit" - means begging for the current of Holy Spirit's breath and breeze.

Living in the Olive Press is the pursuit of a life that is fully dependent upon the Lord Jesus.

I rest in the truth that without HIS breath in my lungs I am utterly lost. With HIS breath in my lungs, I am utterly saved and an heir of the Kingdom of Heaven.

"The Kingdom of Heaven belongs to them" - means the royal reign of the abode of God for eternity. In other words, lay it all down to gain it all freely directly from the Father's hand.

Core value 2. Blessed are THOSE WHO MOURN, for they will be comforted – verse 4.

"Those who mourn" - means the feeling or act of grieving, wailing, feeling guilt.

Living in the Olive Press is embracing repentance of my sin, mourning how my sin nailed HIM to the cross, confessing my sorrow and rejecting the "she's so strong" syndrome.

As God-fearing women called to lead – we can fall into the trap of "I'll be alright." This is a mindset that must be rejected. We are not "alright" without HIM, and we are only "alright" because of HIM.

"For they will be comforted" - means to invite or call near, exhort, intreat, pray.

Embracing the core value of mourning opens the door for the Holy Spirit – the comforter – to come in and restore our joy through deep intimacy with the Trinity.



**Core value 3.** Blessed are THE MEEK, for they will inherit the earth - verse 5.

"The Meek" - means a demeanor of being gentle, meek, kind.

Living in the Olive Press brings tenderness to our inward and outward person – only ripe, tender olives are pressed into oil. As God-fearing women who lead, we consider others better than ourselves; we live to serve the Lord by serving others.

"for they will inherit the earth" - means to obtain by inheritance, full heirs of the whole of the terrene globe, including the occupants.

All Jesus paid at the cross (the ultimate pressing) is "willed" to those who live just as HE lived. It isn't "ours for the asking" it is "ours for the living." Meekness is the open door to look and be like our Lord.

**Core value 4.** Blessed are THOSE WHO HUNGER AND THIRST AFTER RIGHTEOUSNESS, for they will be filled – verse 6.

"Those who hunger and thirst after righteousness" - means being absolutely famished and to suffer from thirst for justice and God's approval.

Living in the Olive Press is standing for the gospel, what is right and good according to the Word of God – God's justice requires us to live a life that is pursuing HIS heart and seeking HIM in the secret place. Living in the Olive Press means abundance on the other side of our sacrifice and suffering.

"They will be filled" - means to gorge. The abundance – the overflow - of the Lord's presence – "the oil" will be so evident in our lives – there will be abundance of oil for our lamps to burn brightly until HE comes. And those around us will either be drawn to HIM or they will hide from HIM because of you. You are called TO BURN BRIGHTLY. THAT TAKES A STORE OF OIL.



**Core value 5.** Blessed are those WHO SHOW MERCY, for they shall be shown mercy. verse 7.

"Who Show Mercy" - means compassionately merciful, full of pity. Living in the Olive Press is embracing our complete dependence on the Lord, and our need for the Father's love and the power of the Holy Spirit – our eyes (the lamp of the body) are filled with the fresh and pure oil of the Lord – so they burn with mercy for those around us.

Living in the Olive Press draws us into transformation - a pliable, pure substance in the Lord's hand. Will this be easy? NO – there is nothing easy about the pressing of the Olive Press. We surrender our flesh to gain HIM. He is mercy.

"They shall obtain mercy" - means mercy and compassion by word and deed specifically by divine grace. The mercy and compassion that will be given to us from the Lord (through the word of God, through each other, even from complete strangers) will be the fruit of what we have sown into everyone and everything around us. There is a promised, guaranteed return.

Core value 6. Blessed are those who are PURE IN HEART for they will see God - verse 8.

"The pure in heart" - "katharos kardia" (which is where we get cardiac catheterization) means clean, clear, pure mind, heart and body – free of all mixture, void of any undesirable elements. Think of olive oil – pure extra virgin oil is translucent, its scent distinct – if it is cloudy and the scent stale – we know the oil is contaminated and rancid.

Living in the Olive Press produces oil that is pure and fresh – the outer shell of the olive is crushed and the oil within is skillfully crafted without contamination. Purity of heart is the oil that keeps our lamps burning. This is obtained by the daily return to the secret place.

"For they will see God" - means God will allow himself to be seen.

Living in the Olive Press is being in the secret place more than anything else – he purifies us and then his voice, his touch, and vision of HIM becomes clear and distinct. The pure in heart are trusted by the Lord. He opens our eyes (the lamp of the body) to see into HIS heart and to know his plans. My heart's cry is for HIM to know and trust me.



**Core value 7.** Blessed are THOSE WHO MAKE PEACE, for they will be called sons of God – verse 9.

"The Peacemakers" - means bold declarer of God's truth in a manner that brings wholeness and healing, peace-loving. In other words, we reconcile those in our life to the Lord. We are not "peacekeepers" we are "peacemakers".

Living in the Olive Press empowers us to speak the truth of the gospel and of the Word of God – and offer an olive branch (if you will), an invitation into life with the Lord as sons. "They will be called Sons of God" - means their name shall be son of God; sharing the nature of the Father.

When Jesus went to Gethsemane – the Olive Press at the base of the Mount of Olives where he delivered this Sermon – it was to make peace between you and the Father. Jesus finished that work on the cross. Every day, I have the privilege of going back to the Olive Press and once again laying down my will, flesh, and emotions to declare the message of peace through the Cross of Christ. Yes, we need fresh oil every single day of our lives.

**Core Value 8.** Blessed are THOSE WHO ARE PERSECUTED BECAUSE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, for the kingdom of heaven is theirs – verse 10.

"Those who are persecuted because of righteousness" - means to be pursued, pressed, given to suffer because of your hunger and thirst for justice and the approval of God (not the approval of man). See Core Value 4.

Living in the Olive Press and the purity of your intimacy with the Lord will only truly be tested in persecution. When we've placed our lives in the Olive Press of HIM – the secret place, prayer, devotion to all these core values – there will be nothing left to crush when the pressing of the world comes. We will respond with each of these core values – instinctively. (Won't that be amazing?!)

"For the kingdom of heaven is theirs" - means the royal reign of the King is yours.

When you live in the Olive Press, there is nothing that separates you from Him. Did you notice we've come full circle from #1? We are bookended with receiving the kingdom of heaven.



Embracing the Olivet discourse as our mentoring core values is an invitation to die to ourselves – and to come alive in the power of the resurrection. Only the dead get resurrected and walk in the power of the resurrection.

Then ask HIM which core value HE wants to form more deeply in you. Tell as much about this journey as you wish. Write your answer in the space below.
Discussion questions:
When considering that one core value that feels central to who you are, how does it influence your routines, your reactions, and the way you carry yourself in different environments?
As you consider the core value—or Beatitude—that the Lord desires to deepen within you, what areas of your heart, mindset, or habits need to shift so you can fully surrender to His transforming work?
