The Atelier Foundation Scholarship Program

The Atelier Foundation Scholarship Program is designed to provide financial support and encouragement to individuals interested in the arts. This scholarship aims to recognize and assist individuals who demonstrate outstanding potential, a strong commitment to their craft, and a passion for the visual and performing arts.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must exhibit a high level of artistic interest and creativity in their chosen medium, whether it be painting, drawing, sculpture, digital art, or any other form of visual or performing art.

While not the primary criterion, a solid academic record is considered. Applicants should maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5.

To qualify for The Atelier Foundation Scholarship, applicants must have a household income classified as low for the state of Arkansas. Eligibility will be reviewed by Foundation members, who will make determinations based on income as well as other criteria. This ensures that our scholarships support those with financial need and align with our mission to make the arts accessible to everyone.

The Atelier Foundation offers an educational service award in the form of tuition-free art classes to the selected recipient(s). There are no monetary funds given to recipients.

The application deadline for The Atelier Scholarships is ongoing. Exact dates of submission requirements will be stated on *AtelierFoundation.org*, as well as our social media sites.

Application Process

- 1. Interested applicants should complete the online scholarship application form available on The Atelier Foundation's official website, *Atelier Foundation.org*.
- 2. Alongside the application form, applicants will submit the following documents to be considered for a scholarship:
 - A portfolio of original artwork (either digital or physical submission)
 - Essay
 - Copies of academic transcripts (attendance records/report cards/GPA)

- Income verification
- Letter(s) of recommendation
- 3. The scholarship committee will review all applications and select the scholarship recipient(s) based on their artistic interest, submitted items, and alignment with the program's objectives. Current availability of funding will also be considered in choosing recipients.

Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by the specified date on *AtelierFoundation.org* through email and/or phone. The award will also be publicly announced on The Atelier Foundation's website and social media platforms.

Scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the business providing services to cover tuition and relevant expenses for the upcoming scholarship period.

Make sure to adhere to the application deadline and submission instructions provided in the scholarship announcement. Any applications that are not submitted in entirety will not be considered. Attachments and submissions should include income information, GPA information, letter of recommendation, essay and/or portfolio (either physical or digital), as well as the completed application.

1. Age Requirements:

• Applicants must be 18 years old or younger.

2. Academic Performance:

• A minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale is required.

3. Financial Eligibility:

• Applicants must come from low-income families, defined as households with incomes at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

For households with more than 8 persons, add \$5,380 for each additional person to the 100% guideline, and \$8,070 to the 150% guideline.

4. Residency:

• Applicants must reside in Arkansas.

5. Interest in the Arts:

• Applicants should demonstrate a genuine interest in the arts, which can be evidenced through a personal statement, portfolio, or recommendation letter.

6. Application Requirements:

• Completed application form.

- Proof of age (e.g., birth certificate, state ID).
- Academic transcripts reflecting GPA.
- Documentation of household income (e.g., recent tax returns, pay stubs) to verify financial eligibility.
- Proof of residency in Arkansas (e.g., utility bill, lease agreement).
- Materials demonstrating interest in the arts (e.g., personal statement, portfolio, recommendation letter).

7. Selection Process:

- Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee to ensure all eligibility criteria are met.
- Eligible applicants may be invited for an interview or audition as part of the selection process.

8. Renewal Criteria:

 Assistance is subject to renewal based on continued eligibility, satisfactory academic progress (maintaining a GPA of 2.5 or higher), and active participation in foundation programs.
