



WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 12 of the Bay County Republican Executive Committee allows for the REC to pass a resolution on behalf of the organization; and

WHEREAS, the resolution regarding the official platform of the Republican National Committee explicitly states that it “enthusiastically supports President Trump” and that “the Republican Party has and will continue to enthusiastically support the President’s America-first agenda;” and

WHEREAS, the role of House Republican Conference Chair is a position that represents the entire GOP within the institution of the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, Representative Elizabeth Cheney (WY) has voted in favor of the impeachment of President Donald J. Trump; and

WHEREAS, this decision stands in conflict with the official position of the Republican National Committee and the wishes of the overwhelming majority of Republican voters that rewarded President Trump’s leadership with the most votes any Republican candidate has ever received in American history; and

WHEREAS, the strength of the Republican Party, and its future electoral success, depends upon fighting for the values and interests of its voters; and

WHEREAS, Rep. Elizabeth Cheney has been censured by the Republican Party of Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, Republican leaders around the country, including: Rep. Matthew Gaetz (FL) Rep. James Jordan (OH), Rep. Matt Rosendale (MT), Rep. Andrew Biggs (AZ), Rep. Marjorie Taylor Greene (GA), has called on Rep. Elizabeth Cheney to be removed from her position; and

WHEREAS, it is the role of a Republican Executive Committee to represent the Republican voters of its county and provide a voice within the organization of the Republican Party; and

WHEREAS, it is vital for the future of the American republic to unify the Republican base for future electoral success;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bay County Republican Party of Florida finds that Rep. Elizabeth Cheney (WY) has betrayed her obligations to the Republican Party and has conducted herself in a manner that makes it impossible for her to be in a position of leadership in the House Republican Caucus; and

BE IT RESOLVED, the Bay County Republican Party calls for Rep. Elizabeth Cheney to step down from her position as House Republican Conference Chair, or be removed from her position by House Republican Leadership.
