


#### Introduction

## You're Kidding!




hen it comes to KNOWING what kind of story we are all in, we really only have CLUES and a few HINTS.

For most of my adult life I have lived as if I had enough FACTS to KNOW the story I'm in.

At first I had to trust what others told me the Bible was about. I listened intently at Church and took notes. I went to Bible college and took more notes. There were many times that I would discover the meaning for myself as I learned how to study on my own. I started by studying through the entire New Testament verse by verse. It took me nine years!

One thing that consistently happened as I studied, and still does to this day, is the fact that the words I studied echoed.



Now, all words echo, don't they? It's not just GOD's word that we hear teaching and reminding us. But only GOD's word can bring us to a place in our lives where we're able to accept GOD's love ... unconditionally. Accepting the love of GOD is not transactional. It is not academic. It is a spiritual thing. It is more caught than taught. I like to think of it as **walking with GOD.** That's the closest description in the Bible to having a relationship with GOD ... since the word "relationship" is barely even in the Bible! Though, we often talk like it is a primary subject. In the first couple of centuries Christianity wasn't the only name that following Jesus was called, it was also known as **The Way**. Isn't that fascinating?

For years after I had studied the Bible I would have to get on with other things, OF COURSE! I'd continue to let what I had studied be like background music to me. I would let it play over and over like a loop. Later, I would have a moment where I'd gain an understanding of what I had been studying. It was as if GOD would bring this moment about for me. I couldn't make this happen. I had to wait for it. But when it finally did happen I would hear the words echo in my soul and I'd receive a transformed life one word at a time! The words would come back to me rich and full of meaning.

Each time the whole experience made me want to know GOD more. What's more, this has created an insatiable hunger for GOD's word in my life. I've never been able to put The Book down! I don't want to! It is where GOD speaks to me.



GOD's word is the word that GOD uses in my life to convince me that GOD is love.

Jesus told the disciples how GOD teaches us and gives us reminders through the Holy Spirit.

"But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will **teach** you all things and will **remind** you of everything I have said to you." John 14:26

Perhaps this is what Paul meant when he wrote to the church in Corinth ...

"This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words."

1 Corinthians 2:13

GOD's reminders come subtly as suggestions, hints, and clues. But they can also come to us like we're being startled from sleep! Whether it happens slowly or in a moment, the result is the same.

# 2 Three Words

ne day I'll stand before GOD. Maybe. I say that because we cannot prove the existence of GOD. But I am satisfied mostly with what I've found out so far.

I believe that life asks us all a question ...

#### is GOD LOVE?


Jesus Christ is the best expression of the 3 words, **GOD is love**. How is that?

Then, write down why they stand out to you. Finally, look at the reasons you wrote that made them stand out and ask yourself how it compares to GOD being crucified for you.

Perhaps the point of it all is for each of us the answer the 3 word question ...

#### is GOD LOVE?

I've spent my life seeking GOD and am satisfied with the
