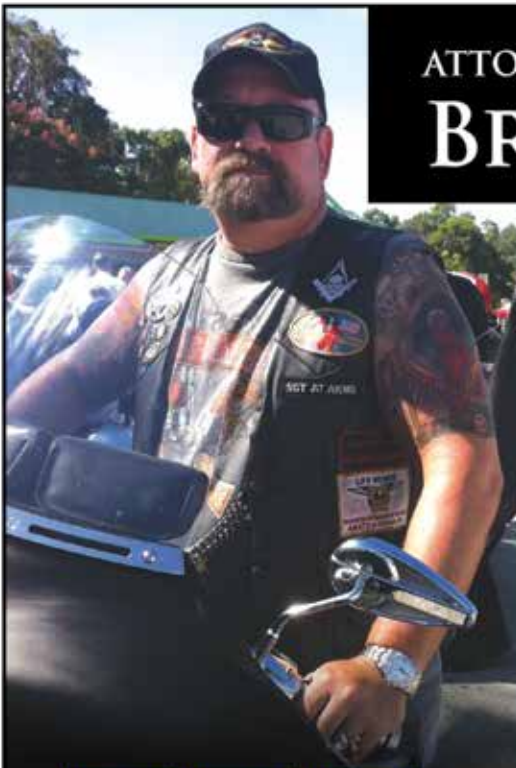

POMPANO BEACH FL, 33060
OCTOBER 15, 2024

The Dangers of Slippery White Lines on Crosswalks

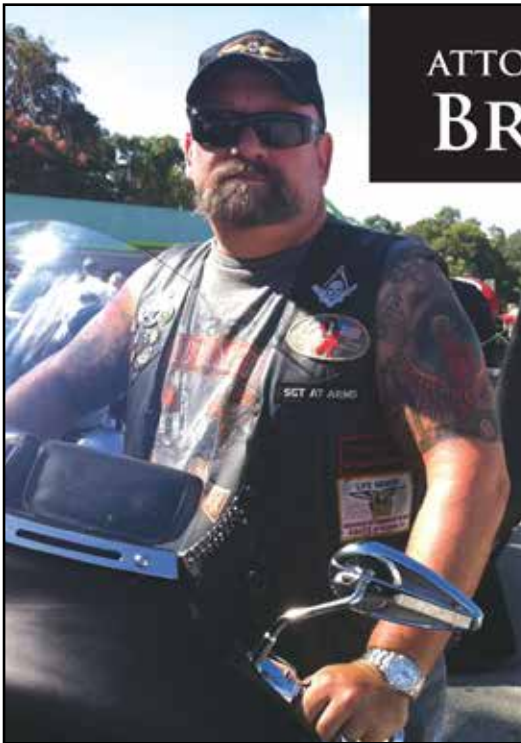

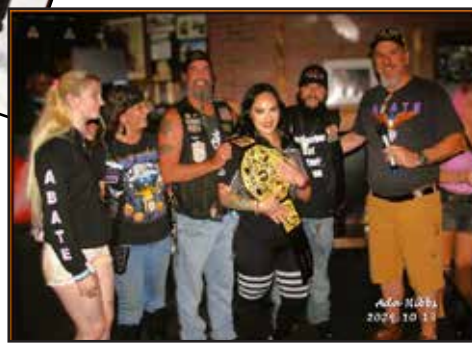

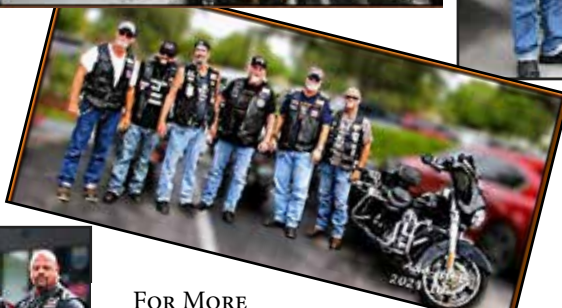

DESCRIPCIÓN DEL PROYECTO

ANTECEDENTES

Florida tiene muchas cosas que ofrecer a los entusiastas de las motocicletas, desde clima soleado, hermosas playas y carreteras panorámicas hasta actividades específicas para motocicletas y eventos como la semana Daytona Bike Week. This was an idea to help raise money for our Chapter, and also to recognize those brothers and sisters who provide extra monetary support, to promote the Chapter's mission. 3. ****Public Awareness Campaigns****: Educating pedestrians about the potential dangers of slippery crosswalks can help them take precautions, such as choosing appropriate footwear and being mindful of weather conditions.

4. ****Improved Signage****: Installing warning signs near crosswalks that are known to be slippery can alert pedestrians to exercise caution, especially during adverse weather conditions.

CONCLUSION

While white lines on crosswalks are a critical component of pedestrian safety, their slipperiness can create significant hazards. By understanding the risks and implementing effective solutions, communities can enhance safety for all road users. As we continue to prioritize pedestrian safety, addressing the issue of slippery white lines should be a key focus for urban planners and local governments alike.

Some of ABATE of Florida, Inc.'s Accomplishments

- On July 1, 2000, we had the 30 year old Florida Helmet law repealed; July 1, 2020 was our 20th Anniversary of Freedom of Choice.
- We've become the 4th largest State Motorcycle Rights Organization (MRO) in the country (IN & IL are 1&2, we regularly switch for 3rd & 4th with PA).
- We got the handlebar heights law modified.
- We successfully fought a bill that would forbid our children from riding on our bikes.
- We successfully fought the bill that would confiscate motorcycles for going 30MPH over the speed limit.
- We developed an effective MSAP program that has raised motorist's perceptions and awareness of motorcycles, and have received funding from the State of FL totaling over \$750,000 to promote motorcycle safety and awareness.
- We successfully fought the bill against vertical tags that had over \$1,100 in fines for a first offense.
- Supported and fought for a texting-while-driving ban for the last few years.
- Our 2009-2010 Stiffer Penalties Bill made it through five of the FL House & Senate's committees; this is the farthest it has gone in the number of years we have tried. On the last day of session, a committee member strenuously attempted to attach a revival of the helmet law to our Bill. To avoid a new helmet law in Florida, we had to kill the Bill.
- We publish monthly Press Releases and/or Articles of Interest in many online & print publications, including Florida Full Throttle.
- The President of ABATE of Florida, Inc. has been asked to be on and currently sits as a member of The Motorcyclist Advisory Council (MAC) to the Federal Highway Administration in Washington, D.C. The Secretary of the U.S. Dept. of Transportation may appoint a representative from only two State MROs throughout the entire U.S.A. to be on this council.
- The President of ABATE of Florida, Inc. sits as the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the National Collation of Motorcyclists (NCOM). NCOM has over 1000 member organizations.

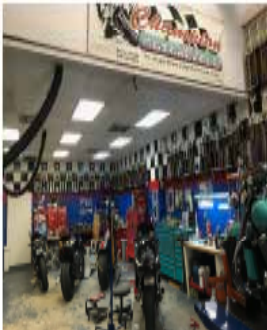

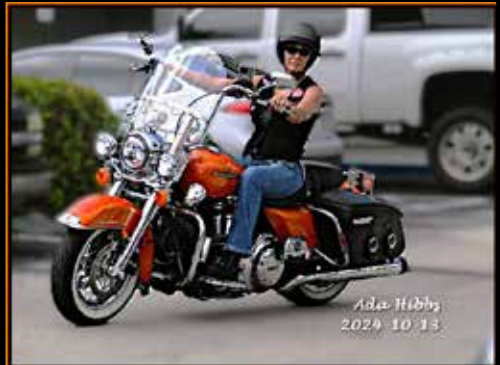

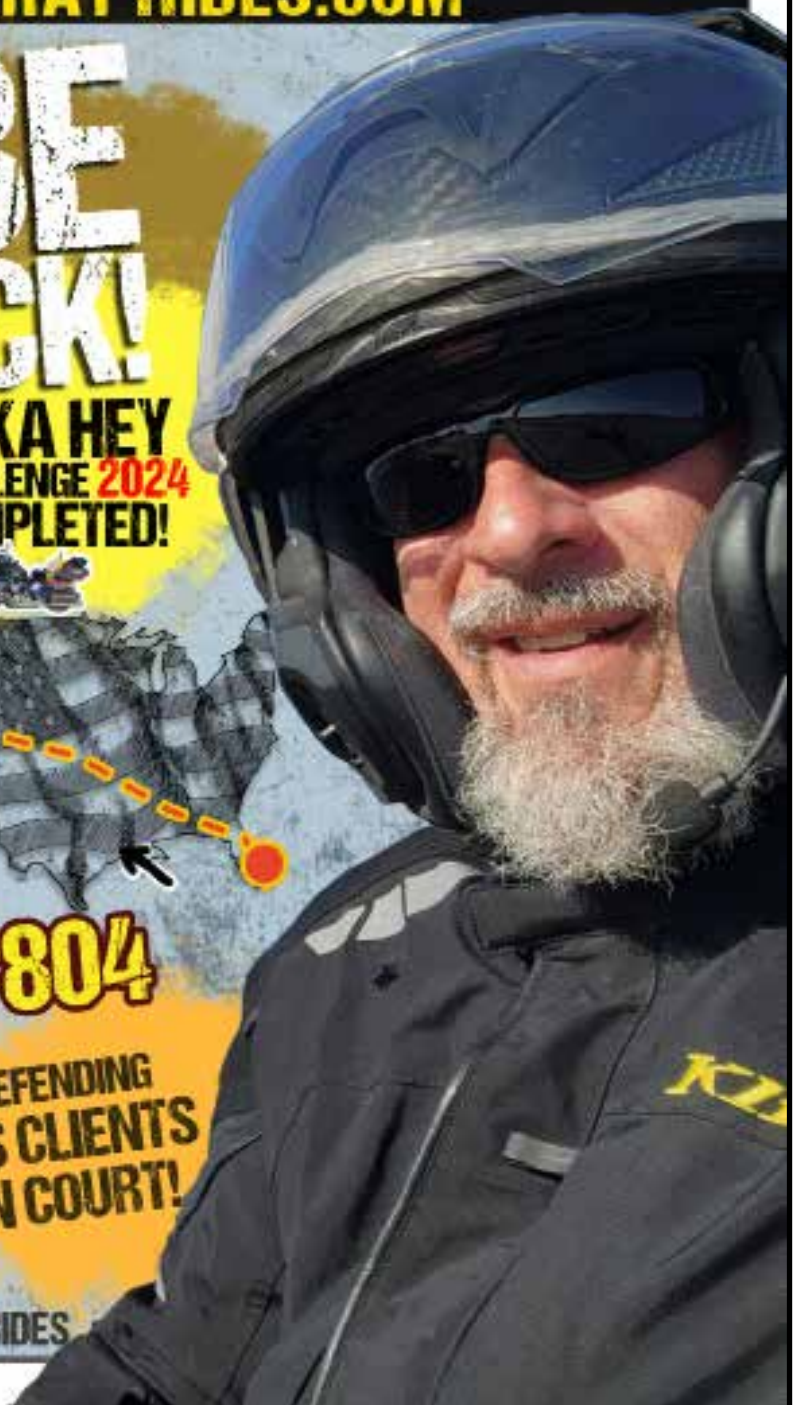
