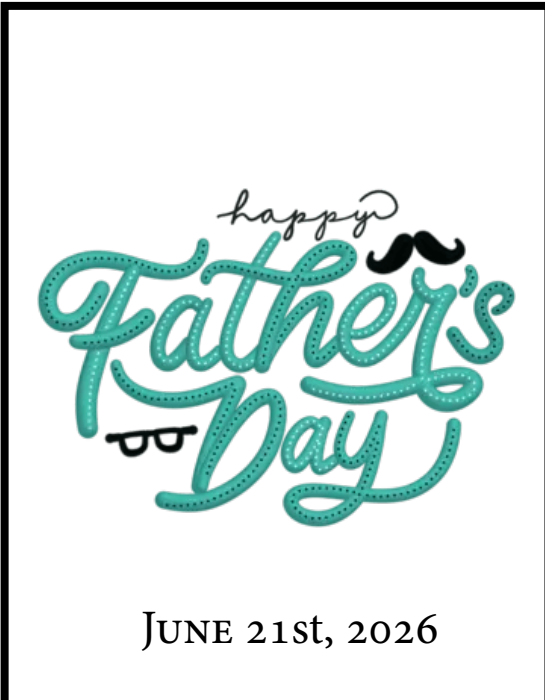


## **ABATE of FLORIDA ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

ABATE was the driving force behind the changes in Florida's Helmet Law. Florida Motorcyclists, over the age of 21 and who carry at least \$10,000 medical insurance coverage now enjoy the Freedom to Choose whether to wear a helmet or not. ABATE has developed & copyrighted "The Motorcycle Safety & Awareness Program" (MSAP). The program is presented to non-motorcyclists to educate them on how to safely share the road with motorcycles. It is taught in local schools & to civic organizations at no charge in the hope of reducing motorcycle accidents and deaths through education, not legislation. ABATE has passed the Vulnerable Road User Bill in 2024, signed by the Governor, for vulnerable road user to pay specified civil penalty; requires person's driver license to be suspended for specified period; requires person to attend specified driver improvement course.

ABATE has gained a positive and respected position in Tallahassee. Because of our Lobbyist and Legislative efforts, State Representatives are aware of ABATE members and our vigilant quest. ABATE reminds travelers every day to "Look Twice Save a Life, Motorcycles are everywhere"

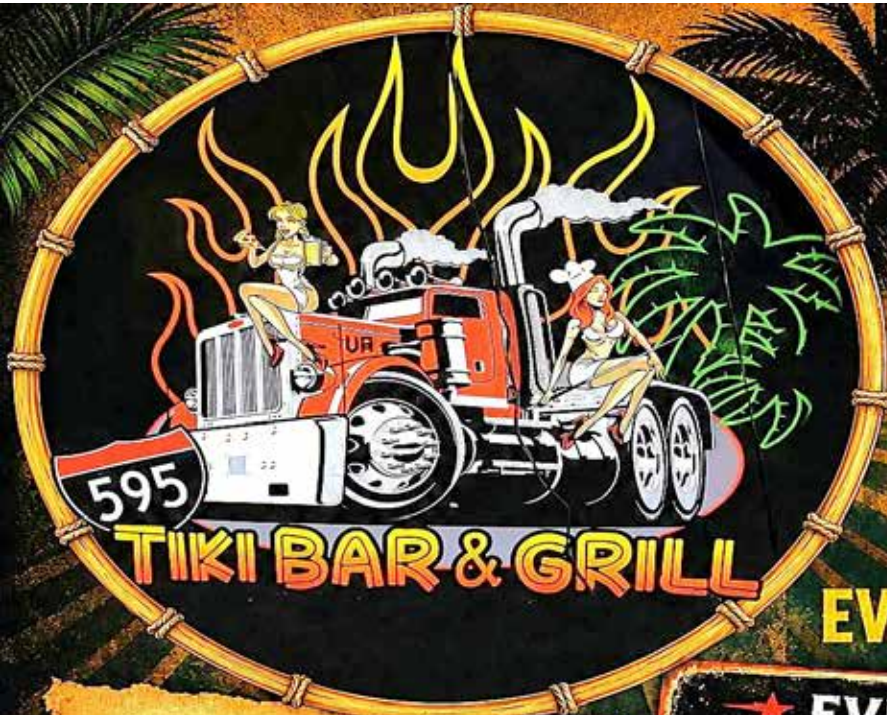

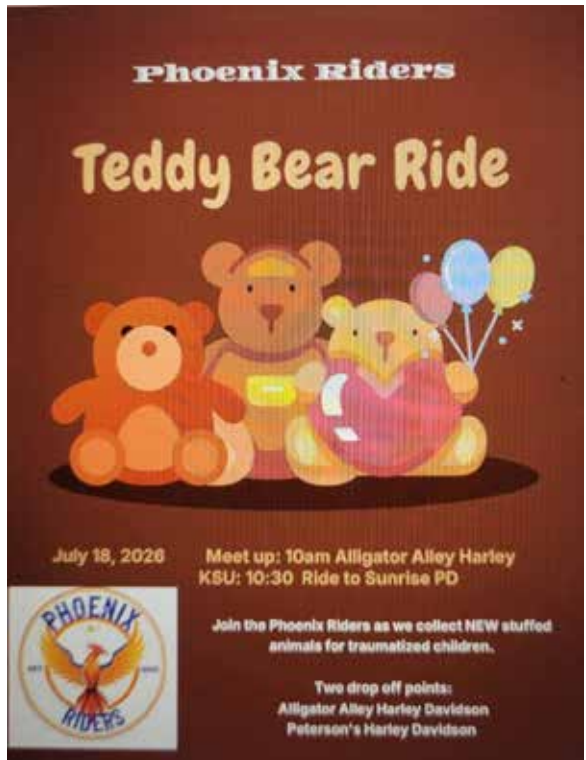

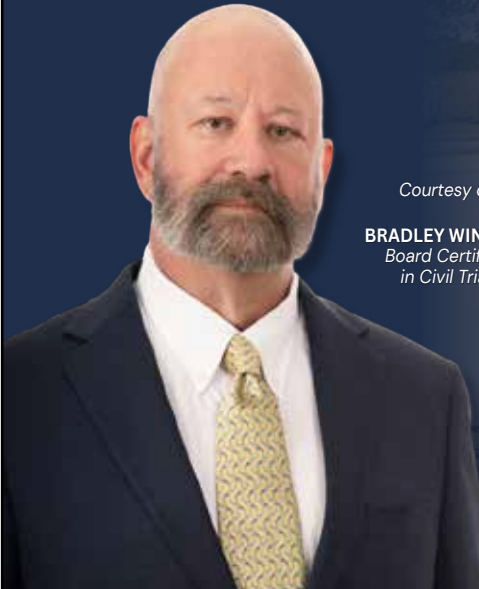

On June 21st, 2026, we celebrate Father's Day. Fathers come in all varieties and have been called by many a name... Dad, Pops, Daddy, Pa, my old man, as well as

words I can't use here. Some of us honor him, and some may choose to forget. Some are still with us, while others have passed. Either way, we all have a father, and some of you are fathers yourself.

Fatherhood has a long history throughout the Bible. The examples range from complex, flawed humans to the ultimate model of a Heavenly Father.

Considering just a few examples, there was Abraham, known as the father of the faithful. He was determined to bring his entire legacy into the promised land, no matter the cost. Abraham is celebrated for trusting God's promises even though it took his entire lifetime to see them fulfilled.

David, who wrote most of the Psalms, was described as a man after God's own heart, yet his family suffered deeply from his lack of discipline and inconsistent leadership. His story is a lesson in both grace and the consequences of family dysfunction. How many of us can relate to this type of upbringing?

Job was the ultimate example of a Godly father who deeply loved his children and regularly prayed for them, even when he couldn't shield them from trouble. Tragedy struck on every side, yet Job chose to worship God, knowing God's plan was always best. In the end, God restored all that Job had lost, blessing him above and beyond what he had.

God gives all sorts of examples of fatherhood,

even situations of adoption. Joseph was the earthly adoptive father of Jesus, stepping in as the ultimate model. He was present in Jesus's life and provided protection along the way. He chose to be obedient to God's will, regardless of the shame that came with his culture.

I've only listed four fathers from the Bible; yet there are so many more. These four examples highlight that fatherhood requires faithful presence rather than perfection, show the importance of spiritual leadership and consistency vs. the lack of it, underline the need to give our children to God through prayer, and underscore the blessings of leaving a multi-generational legacy. Regardless of their shortcomings, they chose to follow God. They knew Him as THEIR Father and trusted Him no matter what.

This Father's Day, if you haven't chosen God, do it today. He knows our every weakness; after all, He created us. He's not the MIA dad you never got to know, but longed to spend time with, or the angry tyrant who ruled you with a fist. He won't shame or belittle you, and He'll never cuss you out or shred you with His words but rather speaks blessings over you while you sleep. It's not too late to let Him show you how to father, nor is it too late to let Him Father you.

"And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death, nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even powers of hell can separate us from God's love." Romans 8:38

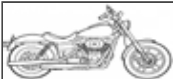

What do you think the first thing she said, after "nice to meet you" was? Boots said, "you don't want to be on my list", meaning the bad list. She scared me, but that moment made such a difference to me. I wanted to be on her good list. I took so many notes and paid intent attention at all the seminars I went to, Secretary and Treasurer among them. I try and do everything correctly, perfect and timely as possible. Even though Boots isn't a part of the State Board or Trustees anymore, I still want to stay on the good list. I think meeting her, and Doc too, made me really understand what an important organization I was now a part of. Sure, we have fun, but we do serious work, and help save lives."

Elizabeth "Boots" Buchholz: Pioneering Change in the Motorcycle Community  
From her childhood fascination with the rumble of motorcycles to her prominent role in advocating for riders' rights, Elizabeth "Boots" Buchholz has transformed her passion into a lifelong commitment to motorcycling and community activism.

#### A Journey Begins

Boots' journey in the motorcycle world began in 1981, when she took her first ride. The thrill of the open road called to her, and she soon joined ABATE (A Brotherhood Against Totalitarian Enactments) of New York to connect with fellow riders. However, it wasn't until she moved to Florida in 1985 that she encountered the first challenge of her advocacy journey.

At one of her first ABATE meetings in Florida, she was shocked to learn that women were not allowed to serve in the organization. Rather than backing down, this revelation ignited a fire within her. "I took it as a challenge," she recalls. "Nothing was going to stop me from making a difference."

#### A Relentless Advocate

Determined to break barriers, Boots threw herself

into the organization, taking on any tasks that others shied away from. Her willingness to fill vacant positions and tackle difficult assignments showcased her unwavering commitment. Boots attended numerous conferences and seminars hosted by the AMA (American Motorcyclist Association), NCOM (National Coalition of Motorcyclists), and the MRF (Motorcycle Riders Foundation), absorbing knowledge and returning to share her insights with the organization.

Over the years, Boots has held multiple roles within ABATE of Florida, including member, National Representative, State Legislative Trustee, and State Secretary. Today, she serves as the State Office Manager, a position that has earned her the title of “the backbone of ABATE of Florida.” For more than two decades, Boots has worked tirelessly to strengthen the organization and amplify the voices of motorcyclists across the state.

#### Championing Motorcyclists’ Rights

Boots’ dedication has had a profound impact on ABATE of Florida, leading to significant achievements, including the amendment of the state’s helmet law. Her extensive knowledge of motorcyclists’ issues has taken her to Washington, D.C., where she has lobbied legislators on behalf of riders. Her talent for advocacy extends beyond verbal persuasion; she has also contributed to the written word, being published in the MRF’s White Papers, further influencing policies that affect riders nationally.

As a passionate rider herself, Boots is particularly committed to promoting women in motorcycling. She actively works to ensure that female riders are recognized, encouraged, and empowered to take their rightful place in the community. “I believe in fighting for my rights, and my children’s rights, and my grandchildren’s rights,” she asserts, embodying the spirit of advocacy that drives her work.

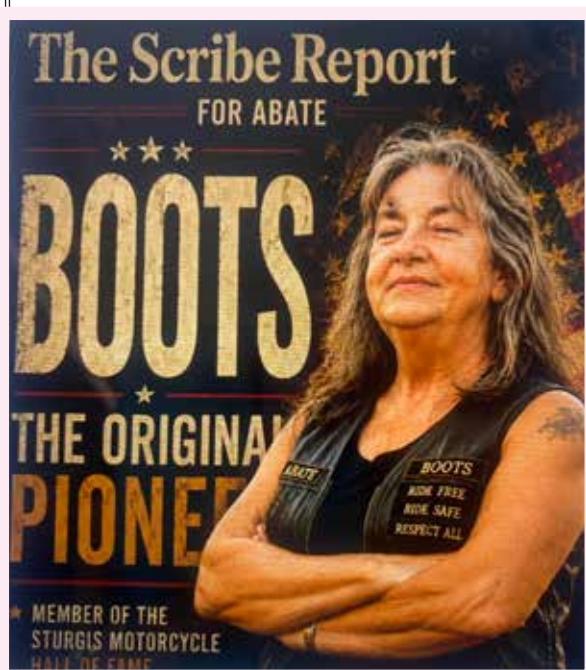
#### A Legacy of Change
