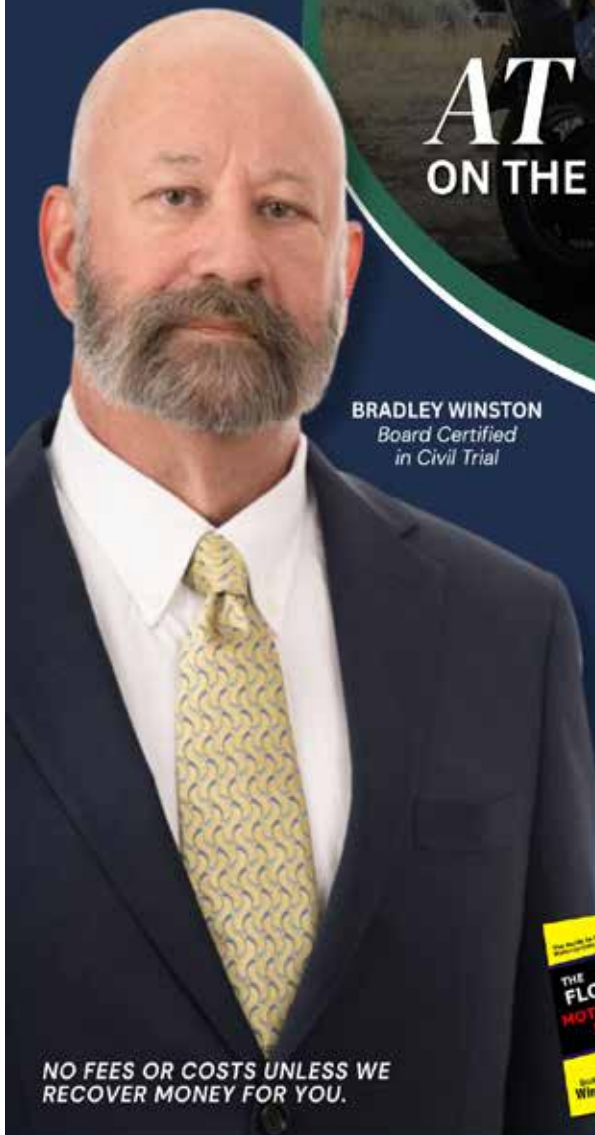

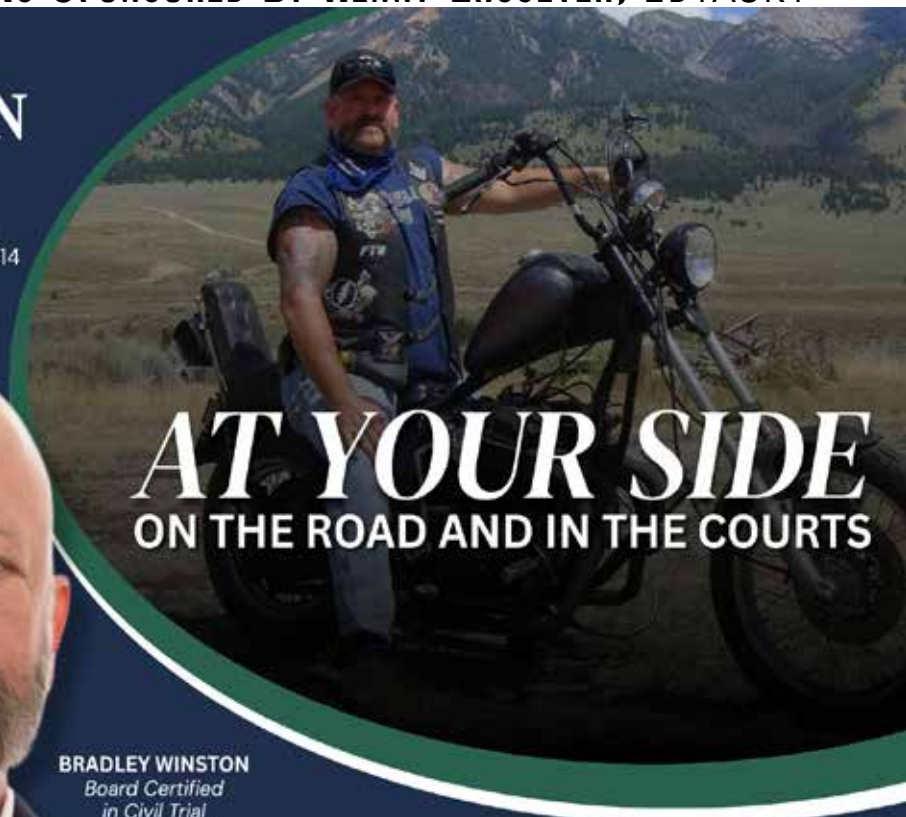

ABATE of FLORIDA ACCOMPLISHMENTS

ABATE was the driving force behind the changes in Florida's Helmet Law. Florida Motorcyclists, over the age of 21 and who carry at least \$10,000 medical insurance coverage now enjoy the Freedom to Choose whether to wear a helmet or not. ABATE has developed & copyrighted "The Motorcycle Safety & Awareness Program" (MSAP). The program is presented to non-motorcyclists to educate them on how to safely share the road with motorcycles. It is taught in local schools & to civic organizations at no charge in the hope of reducing motorcycle accidents and deaths through education, not legislation. ABATE has passed the Vulnerable Road User Bill in 2024, signed by the Governor, for vulnerable road user to pay specified civil penalty; requires person's driver license to be suspended for specified period; requires person to attend specified driver improvement course.

ABATE has gained a positive and respected position in Tallahassee. Because of our Lobbyist and Legislative efforts, State Representatives are aware of ABATE members and our vigilant quest. ABATE reminds travelers every day to "Look Twice Save a Life, Motorcycles are everywhere"

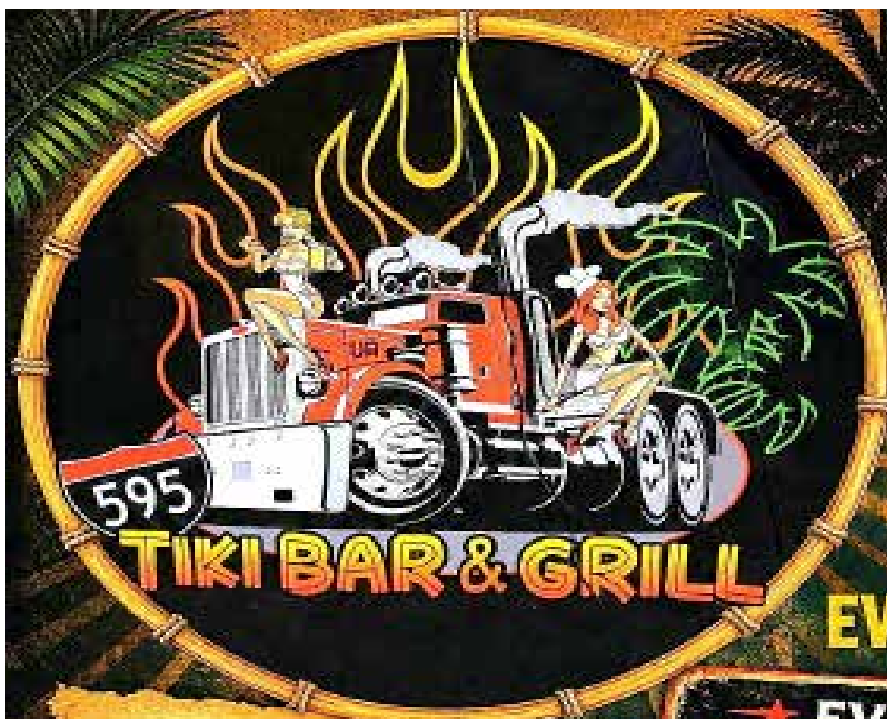
Event flyers are on the tables.

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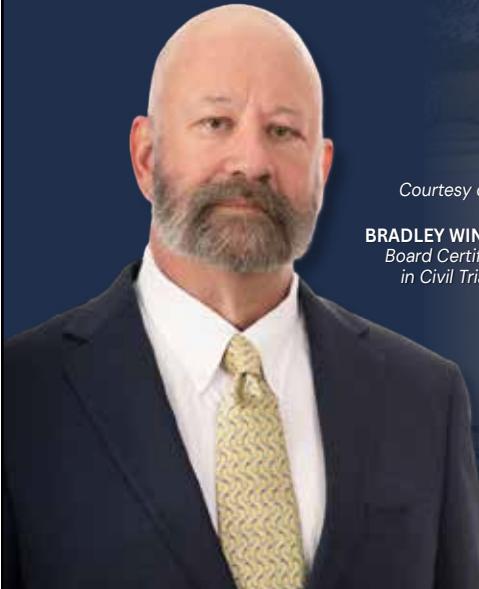


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DOES THIS GET UNDER YOUR SKIN?

But I have come to realize that HOW I respond to these situations, whether internally or externally, is really what's on the line.

No matter how hard, Colossians 3:13 reminds us to "Make allowance for each other's faults and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others."

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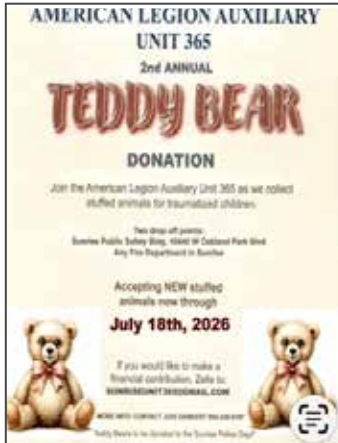
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2ND ANNUAL PHOENIX RIDERS TEDDY BEAR RUN.



The original ride was organized to support the American Legion Auxiliary Post 365. When one of the Auxiliary members approached me and asked if Phoenix Riders would be interested in supporting their cause, I felt truly honored. We gladly accepted the challenge and immediately started spreading the word.

This became Phoenix Riders' second major charity ride during our first year as a group. With 18 motorcycles and 21 riders, we raised 300 teddy bears for the Sunrise Police Department—a tremendous accomplishment that made a real difference.

As planning began for this year's ride, the American Legion Auxiliary and Phoenix Riders agreed on one goal: to surpass what we had accomplished the year before.

I dedicated countless hours to promoting the event by visiting dealerships, posting across social media, sharing information by word of mouth, and speaking with independent riders about our mission and why this ride mattered. We had an incredible turnout of 41 motorcycles

We are already excited to see what we can accomplish together next year!

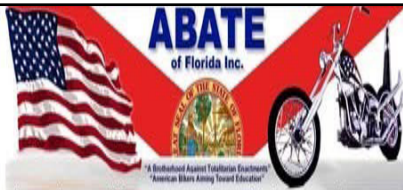

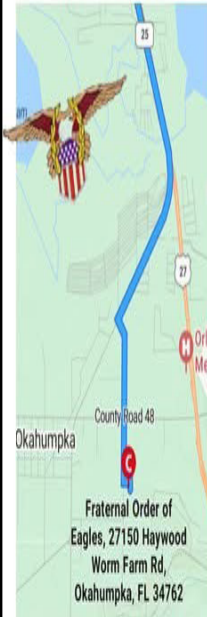

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SELECTING THE RIGHT TYPE OF MOTORCYCLE TO RIDE

For first time riders, choosing the right motorcycle is one of the most important decisions a rider can make. With so many styles and engine sizes available, selecting a bike that matches your experience, riding goals, and comfort level will make every ride safer and more enjoyable.

New riders should begin by honestly evaluating their skill level. A lightweight motorcycle with a manageable engine size, typically between 500cc and 750cc, provides enough power for city streets and highways without being overwhelming. Learning proper riding techniques on a smaller motorcycle also builds confidence and develops good habits that will carry over to larger bikes later.

Your intended use should also influence your decision. If you plan to commute every day, a standard or naked motorcycle offers an upright seating position, easy handling, and excellent fuel economy. Riders who enjoy long-distance travel may prefer a touring motorcycle equipped with comfortable seating, luggage compartments, and wind protection. Those who crave acceleration and aggressive handling often choose sport bikes, while cruisers provide a relaxed riding position and classic styling for leisurely highway rides. Comfort is another essential factor. Sit on several motorcycles before making a purchase. Make sure both feet can comfortably touch the ground, the handlebars are within easy reach, and the controls feel natural. A motorcycle that fits your body properly reduces fatigue and improves overall control.

Budget should extend beyond the purchase price. Riders should also account for insurance, maintenance, riding gear, registration, fuel, and acces-

sories. Sometimes a less expensive motorcycle leaves room in the budget for a high-quality helmet, protective jacket, gloves, boots, and rider training courses—all worthwhile investments.

Finally, avoid choosing a motorcycle simply because it looks impressive. The best motorcycle is one that suits your experience, lifestyle, and riding ambitions. By selecting a bike that fits your needs today, you'll gain valuable experience, ride with greater confidence, and enjoy many safe and memorable miles on the road.

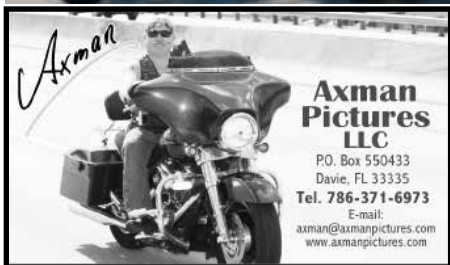
together to achieve extraordinary things. Through the simple act of riding together, they inspire hope, foster unity, and change lives—one mile at a time.

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CAPTAIN'S CORNER

GRAND CANYON NATIONAL PARK

Summer 2018

My journey through America's national parks began at one of the most extraordinary places on Earth—Grand Canyon National Park. Although I had seen countless photographs over the years, nothing prepared me for my first view from the South Rim. Standing at the edge of the canyon, I was overwhelmed by its immense size, brilliant colors, and endless layers of rock stretching to the horizon. It was one of those rare moments when reality surpassed every expectation.

The Grand Canyon is a geological masterpiece, carved by the Colorado River over millions of years while exposing rock formations nearly two billion years old. Measuring 277 miles long, up to 18 miles wide, and more than a mile deep, it stands as one of the world's greatest natural wonders.

Long before it became a national park, Native American peoples lived in and around the canyon, maintaining a deep connection to this remarkable landscape. During a visit in 1903, President Theodore Roosevelt recognized its importance and became a leading advocate for its preservation. His efforts helped lead to the creation of Grand Canyon National Park in 1919.

As I walked along the rim, I found myself stopping often, not because I was tired, but because each overlook revealed another breathtaking panorama. The changing sunlight painted the canyon in shades of gold, red, and purple, making every view seem unique. Standing there, I felt humbled by the immense forces of nature that created such a magnificent place.
