

#### Some of ABATE of Florida, Inc.'s Accomplishments

- On July 1, 2000, we had the 30 year old Florida Helmet law repealed; July 1, 2020 was our 20th Anniversary of Freedom of Choice.
- We've become the 4th largest State Motorcycle Rights Organization (MRO) in the country (IN & IL are 1&2, we regularly switch for 3rd & 4th with PA).
- We got the handlebar heights law modified.
- We successfully fought a bill that would forbid our children from riding on our bikes.
- We successfully fought the bill that would confiscate motorcycles for going 30MPH over the speed limit.
- We developed an effective MSAP program that has raised motorist's perceptions and awareness
  of motorcycles, and have received funding from the State of FL totaling over \$750,000 to promote
  motorcycle safety and awareness.
- ▶ We successfully fought the bill against vertical tags that had over \$1,100 in fines for a first offense.
- Supported and fought for a texting-while-driving ban for the last few years.
- Our 2009-2010 Stiffer Penalties Bill made it through five of the FL House & Senate's committees;
   this is the farthest it has gone in the number of years we have tried. On the last day of session, a committee member strenuously attempted to attach a revival of the helmet law to our Bill. To avoid a new helmet law in Florida, we had to kill the Bill.
- We publish monthly Press Releases and/or Articles of Interest in many online & print publications, including Florida Full Throttle.
- The President of ABATE of Florida, Inc. has been asked to be on and currently sits as a member of The Motorcyclist Advisory Council (MAC) to the Federal Highway Administration in Washington, D.C. The Secretary of the U.S. Dept. of Transportation may appoint a representative from only two State MROs throughout the entire U.S.A. to be on this council.
- The President of ABATE of Florida, Inc. sits as the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the National Collation of Motorcyclists (NCOM). NCOM has over 1000 member organizations.

#### CAPTAIN'S CORNER

#### IRON BUTT ASSOCIATION

This month's article is about the Iron Butt Association (IBA). I have been a "member" now for over 15 years. The IBA boasts over 80,000 members throughout the United States and several other countries. It was formed in 1984 to is no "formal" membership. There are at least 400 IBA rides, from the challenging to the absolutely ridiculous.


All rides are set up that you can complete the ride safely within the given time allotment. That would mean basically honoring the speed limits (more or less) and having adequate time for a short nap to keep you fresh and safe. "Membership" is available after you complete one ride.

The most basic ride is the Saddle Sore 1000. This requires the rider to cover 1000 miles within 24 hours. Once you accomplish this or any other IBA ride, you can fill out the "membership" application and pay the minimal fee to become an Iron Butt "member". What do you get for your hard riding? You get a certificate worthy of framing and a patch for your vest. AND BRAGGING RIGHTS to other riders that think riding to Daytona is a big deal!

The website, https://www.ironbutt.org/, provides/ details as to what you must include to get credit for the ride. Basically, you need to keep a log and receipts of your gas stops, any bridge or road tolls, sometimes a picture of your starting point and ending point and sometimes a form completed and signed by possibly a police officer or another person at the beginning and end of your ride. These requirements vary somewhat depending on the ride. The BOTTOM LINE is that you are on your honor.

My experience with the IBA to date is simply the Saddle Sore 1000. I have a few other rides in mind and I hope to complete them before I get too much older. One is the 50CC. This is coast to coast (Atlantic to Pacific oceans) in 50 hours or less. You can take any route you wish but the most common and sensible would be from Jacksonville to San Diego along route 10. Another ride that has my interest is the Key West to Prudhoe Bay, Alaska in 30 days. The real challenge here is the last hundred miles or promote long distance motorcycle riding. There so up the Ice Highway. As I understand, this is a rough gravel road. Very tough on both the bike and the rider. Again, these are just two rides that I would like to accomplish, but there are another 400 that looks like fun too. Next month I will recap my Saddle Sore 1000 experience.



OK, I'm not sure which pisses me off more, semitrucks riding in the left lane on the turnpike or cars driving slow in the left lane. Either way, it causes other vehicles to cut me off, trying to get around them. And that's bad enough in a cage but it really sucks when you're on your bike. And it is against Florida Law too, F.S. 316.081, that drivers are to drive on the right side of roadways except when passing another vehicle or avoiding an obstruction. Otherwise, no drivers are allowed to continuously drive in the left lane.

It is Florida law that if you are driving slower than the speed limit, you have to stay as close as possible to the right-hand curb except when passing another vehicle or preparing for a left turn.

It is Florida law that if you are driving in the left lane while vehicles behind you are approaching at a faster speed, you must change to a right-hand lane. Slow left lane drivers can cause a dangerous driving environment. Aggressive drivers will often tailgate slow drivers in the left lane, swerve into a right-hand lane, speed up drastically, and then swerve back into the left lane in front of the slow driver. We see this all of the time on congested highways. And F.S. 316.074, the current truck lane criterion in Florida includes 6-lane interstate. Trucks are restricted from the left or inside travel lane, leaving it specifically for automobile traffic. Bunch of lawless drivers, not good for us bikers. And just for the record, there are signs on the turnpike that say "no trucks left lane" and "slower traffic keep right".

But even though I don't like it, the left-hand lane violators, I really think the troopers should worry more about trucks and cars going slow and causing chaos instead of worrying about the speeders. So many of them are busy on their phones, trying to figure out where they are going, or someplace good to eat "near me". I'm just sayin', you know.


So, a couple of days last week, it was raining,

so hard, and visibility was terrible. And to make It worse, every other car had their flashers on. That's one of the stupidest things that I only see in South Florida. And you know what kills me? There're big signs on the turnpike that read "Flashers off, lights on". This is just a recommendation though, from the AAA. It used to be illegal in Florida, but a new law was passed in 2021, now makes it legal, stupid, but legal, "but only on highways with speed limits at or above 55 mph and only when conditions create "extremely low visibility."

So, I can't see well because of the rain hitting my glasses and I got blinking lights everywhere. Lucky for me, I was a surfer for many years, many times in storms and a few hurricanes, to get the good waves, you know, so my brain is used to sh&tty weather, and that translates to my highway riding. But it did make it confusing to everyone, flashing lights everywhere, and even to troopers who see the flashing lights as a signal for help from a disabled vehicle. And the flashers also can override turn signals, so you don't know if someone is coming over into your lane. And WE, bikers, have to make sure everybody sees us, and the flasher drivers too busy trying to figure out their phones. Dumb a\$\$es.

\*Educate, don't legislate" stuff we thought you might like to know


We were sitting around talking the other day, first in Thunder's back garden, and then, because we are not crazy, we went inside, out of the heat. It just seems so hot these days, except when we got the grandkids and are poolside. Riding, of course, is hot too, but better in the wind, to help cool everything off. So we got to talking about riding and speed, and we know, most of you know, that Harley Davidson set the land speed record back in 1937. What, you didn't know? Well, let us Educate you.

Since the invention of the motorcycle, riders, engineers and manufacturers have been united in

the pursuit of speed. From Glenn Curtiss's 64 mph in 1903 to the current record of 376.363 mph, the motorcycle land speed record has a long history. Harley-Davidson has made its own mark on this history.

In 1936, Harley-Davidson decided to try their hand at land speed racing. This was a time when speed land records played an important role in the marketing of motorcycle and automobile brands. Other private race teams had previously used Harley-Davidson powered motorcycles, but this was to be the first "official" factory-built land speed racer. Harley Davidson started with a 1937 EL model which was powered by their new overhead valve 61ci Knucklehead motor. Then they added low-slung handlebars and made a custom fairing using part of a gas tank that was reshaped to fit over the front forks. For additional aerodynamics, they added a rear tail fin assembly.

By March of 1937, the motorcycle was ready to make an attempt at a new record. During testing, it was discovered that the tail fin produced enough unwanted vibration that it was removed for the actual record attempt. They then added low handlebars and made a custom fairing using part of a gas tank that was reshaped to fit the front



forks. Harley Davidson chose factory racer Joe Petrali to pilot the motorcycle.

"Smoky" Joe was born in San Francisco, California on February 22, 1904. Petrali's taste for motorcycles began to grow in California as a child, he watched the Class A racers of the 1910s, such as Charles "Fearless" Balke or Don Johns. He later adopted Charles' style and began wearing similar leather pants and leg warmers throughout his career. At the age of 14, he obtained his first national victory when he participated in an "economy run" race held at the California State Fairgrounds, in Sacramento.

Petrali continued to participate in endurance races over the next three years, among others, he participated in an endurance race that was recognized as a record, a marathon that lasted three days and four nights, after all other riders withdrew, the race was considered a tie between Petrali and his boss Archie Rife. Petrali was a Class A racing champion, competing in board track, dirt track, speed records and hillclimb. won a record total of 49 AMA (American Motorcyclist Association) national championship races, his last victory was on August 29, 1937, this record of victories

lasted 55 years until it was broken by Scott Parker in 1992.

But for this article, the main one, is that, on March 13, 1937, he set a record of 136.183 miles per hour on the sands of Daytona Beach, Florida, an experimental 61 cubic inch HARLEY-DA-VIDSON OHV. His mark, on sand, was never surpassed,

although the speed mark was surpassed 11 years later in Bonneville.

Petrali died of a heart attack on November 10, 1973, in Casa Grande, Arizona, while participating in an "economy run".

Another notable example is Cal Rayborn's 1970 record set with a single-engine Sportster™ Streamliner.

Cal Rayborn began riding motorcycles when he was just eight years old, and by sixteen was participating in scrambles in San Diego. Self-described as "wild and woolly," Rayborn frequently crashed. His first professional road race, held in Riverside, California in 1958, nearly ended in tragedy as Rayborn and another rider, while trying to beat each other at a turn, hit a bank on the side of the road and were thrown into the air. With a broken foot and back, Rayborn spent six months in casts.

Rayborn's career was marked by impressive speed, daring and determination. He set a new record to win the 100-Mile National Championship Road Race in Loudon, New Hampshire in 1968, beating the former record of 26:01 by five minutes.

He was the first racer to average over 100 mph at Daytona, which he won in both 1968 and 1969. Following a crash at Ascot Park in 1966. with a cast on his leg and doctor's orders not to race again a month, for Rayborn cut the cast off himself and won a race at Carlsbad the next weekend.



A year later at Carlsbad, he crashed while leading, but re-entered the race and finished without brakes.

Rayborn's fearless determination made him perfectly suited to pursuing the motorcycle land speed record.

From 1966 to 1970, the motorcycle land speed record was held by Bob Leppan. To beat his 245.667 mph record, engineers Dennis Manning and Warner Riley created a 16-foot streamliner powered by a single Harley-Davidson® Sportster® engine. The streamliner chassis was designed and built by Manning, while Riley prepared the engine, modified to an 89 cubic inch displacement running on a fuel mixture supplied by George Smith of Viola, Wisconsin. The engine was mounted directly in front of the rear wheel, with a chain drive.

To fit in the streamliner, Rayborn rode nearly horizontal. With the front tire ahead of him, his forward vision was minimal, and Rayborn used clear plastic panels on either side of the wheel to watch the black stripes marking the edges of the track. Small, pneumatically operated skids in front of the rear wheel kept the streamliner balanced while stationary and at low speeds - "low" being 100 mph! Rayborn retracted them as the streamliner picked up speed and extended them as the bike slowed after the run, leaning to the side to 'feel for the skid'. After one early run the skid failed to fully extend, and when Rayborn leaned to find the skid, it dug into the salt. The rear wheel lifted, and the streamliner was thrown into a series of barrel rolls at around 100 mph. Rayborn was fortunately uninjured, and back in the cockpit for another practice run after the crew worked through the night and the next day to repair the damage.

By the time Rayborn took his official turn on the salt flats, there was a new record to beat. Just a couple weeks earlier, Don Vesco had become the first motorcyclist with a successful run over 250 mph, setting a record of 251.924 mph with a double engine Yamaha streamliner. Undaunted, Rayborn took to the salt on October 15, and set a new

world record of 255.380 mph. But even this was not enough for Rayborn, and the team returned the next day for another try. With a south run of 266.785, and a return of 264.200, Rayborn rocketed to his second land speed record in two days, with a final time of 265.492 mph.

Don Vesco topped the record in 1974 with a speed of 281.702 mph. Tragically, Rayborn would never get the chance to reclaim the title. In December 1973, Cal Rayborn was killed during a race in New Zealand, when a borrowed Suzuki seized, and he was thrown into a wall during a turn. Rayborn's death was a shocking loss for the motorcycling community, and he is remembered as one of the greatest road racers in the sport's history.

We don't know how cooling the speed of these two racers were for them, but we all think they are super cool, and they both had thrills we can only dream of.




