## OUR SAVIOR'S LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES September 3, 2025

These minutes were recorded at the last council meeting and will be approved at the next meeting

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on Wednesday, September 3, 2025 in fellowship hall. Members present were Chad Coulter, Chad Beranek, Kari Halter, Deb Furth, Kris Vollmer, Janice Werner, John Smith, Steve Halter, Justtina Erickson and Pastor Tom Sahl.

President Coulter called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and Pastor Tom led the group in prayer.

<u>Secretary's Report</u>: Steve H moved and Kris V seconded to approve the August minutes as presented by Deb through an email. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Kari reported the August checking balance of \$14,832.85 and savings balance of \$61,657.34. On a motion by Chad B and seconded by Steve H, the treasurer's report was approved.

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> Pastor Tom Sahl has arrived as our interim pastor and has started his duties here.

#### **Committee Reports**

<u>Care Team Visit report:</u> Care teams are making visits and visits are going well.

Education: Justtina reported that they met on August 20 to finalize the schedule for the upcoming Sunday School year. There was a teacher meeting tonight Sept. 3, to finalize plans. Rally Sunday is this coming Sunday and Sunday School children will meet at 9 AM and have craft activities with regular classes to begin Sunday, Sept. 14. There will be no confirmation classes on Wednesday, Sept. 17 (Pastor will be gone), but there will be class on Wednesday, Sept. 24 (different than what is on the September calendar).

Worship and Music: Janice had no report.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: Kris reported that they met on Monday, Sept. 1, 2025. Rally Sunday will be Sunday, September 7 with a potluck following the 10 AM church service. Hamburgers and hot dogs will be provided.

This is a way to serve our fellow members and the committee is asking that church members sign up and take a turn to serve for this. They will meet again on Monday, Nov. 3, 2025 at 7 PM. Thank you's were read from mission donations.

<u>Property:</u> John reported that the air conditioner has been repaired in the back of fellowship hall and that the water heater was replaced at the parsonage. A motion was made by Chad B to order a fire stick for the parsonage TV. John seconded. Motion carried.

You may also leave donations at St. Joesph's before that evening as well. If you prefer you may also donate cash or checks (made out to WAFER).


