

OUR SAVIOR'S LUTHERAN CHURCH **COUNCIL MINUTES** March 3, 2021

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on March 3, 2021 following Lenten services in Fellowship Hall. Members present were: Cory Blomgren, Susan Jeckell, Kevin Juhnke, Chantel Neperman, John Smith, Janice Werner, Misty Willhite and Pastor Todd Mathison. Absent were Todd Horning and Kris Vollmer.

President Blomgren called the meeting to order. Pastor Todd led the group in prayer.

Secretary's Report: February minutes were read by Susan. On a motion by Chantel, seconded by Kevin, the regular monthly minutes for February 2021 were approved. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report: Chantel reported checking balance \$30,714.32 and savings balance of \$29284.71. The 2nd draw of PPP loan was looked into, and we do not qualify. On a motion by John, seconded by Janice the report was approved. Motion carried.

Education: Education committee did not meet this month. First Communion was postponed due to weather- rescheduled for March 7, 2021.

Worship & Music: New altar cloths will be used beginning this Sunday, March 7th, 2021.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: March's mission is the 2022 Luther League Mission Trip. Life, Growth & Stewardship will meet in March/April to brainstorm ideas for use of the Mission Endowment funds to present to Council.

Property: Kevin reported the trim on the entry steps will be repaired.

Description of the current year. We will be looking to fill this position as soon as possible. Members were also asked to gather new activity possibilities for the youth to engage in. Discussion on the use of Fellowship Hall for private parties was had. There was a motion by Janice and 2nd by Kevin to once again use Fellowship Hall for private gatherings, following state guidelines on occupancy and social distancing. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Todd reported a quieter month, but very happy news of being able to return to VVM for visits. He presented the need to upgrade our CCLI license to include streaming and to add a second "seat" to the Presentation Software. On a motion by Janice, seconded by Chantel, it was approved to upgrade and to add a second seat. Motion carried.

With no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Chantel, second by John. The next Council Meeting will be April 7th at 7:00pm. The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.






