# OUR SAVIOR'S LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES March 8, 2023

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on Wednesday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 in the fellowship hall beginning at 7:40, following the Lenten service. Members present were Kevin Graff, Kari Halter, Deb Furth, John Smith, Janice Werner, Kurt Willhite, Courtney Thram, Steve Halter, Brian Benedict and Pastor Carl Billings. Guest present was Char Graff.

President Graff called the meeting to order and led the group in prayer.

<u>Secretary's Report</u>: February council minutes were read by Deb. John moved and Steve seconded to approve as read. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Kari reported the February checking balance of \$43,205.39 and savings balance of \$45,878.55. On a motion by Steve and seconded by Janice, the report was approved Motion carried.

# **Committee Reports**

Education: Courtney reported that trust paid for the confirmation retreat expenses. Nursery to 5<sup>th</sup> grade will sing at the March 26 service. They are working on VBS curriculum and waiting to see when the school year ends to set the dates for VBS. Looking at March 23 as a possible date for confirmation interviews. Confirmation classes have been cancelled 5 times so far due to weather so are looking at doing a few longer sessions to make up for the loss of time. Possibilities might be March 21 and 28. Deb moved to pay Pastor Mike double on those dates for his time. Janice seconded. Motion carried

The school is looking to start the program this spring, and then resume in the fall. 2<sup>nd</sup> Harvest, the WAFER food shelf out of Wabasso and Red Rock Central are working together to implement this program. OSLC will assist with this program as we are able.

# A Note from Mission to Mississippi:

On behalf of those who made the trip to Greenville, Mississippi, and on behalf of the people of Greenville who were richly served and who are deeply grateful, I send this word of APPRECIATION!

Some of you made that trip, some of you sent significant money to pay for construction materials and supplies, some of you sent gifts "in kind" such as windows, chocolate chip cookies, quilts etc, and many of you continued in intercessory prayer for the mission. Glory to God! The chief carpenter tells me this: "A home in which an older woman, her adult son and several grand-childrenlived, received major treatment. A new roof was installed over all, three-fourths of the floors in the house had to be rebuilt, windows were installed, numerous rooms were gutted,

insulated, sheet-rocked and painted. New siding for about half the house was added.

One feature encourages us: the adult resident son worked very hard, and indeed finished the project after we left.

Paul Huls tells me, "We had no illness, no injuries, and all the participants traveled the 1,000 miles to Greenville and safely home. Again, many thanks!






