Dear Friend,

As we enter into the season of Advent and Christmas, I remember words that our Lord Jesus spoke to his disciples (and to us): *Seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well. Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom (Luke 12:31-32).* The reason I am mindful of these promises from God is that they speak in direct confrontation to the uncertainty we face in our immediate context: Covid, national & regional elections, along with the myriad other challenges each of us face in our own unique life journey.

One of the main themes of Advent is this: "God with us." That's what the word Emmaunel means: "God with us." Let me make it more personal: "God with you!" Do you feel that? Know that deep down? Or might God feel distant from you these days? Well, that's where regular time in God's word, in worship of our Lord Jesus, and in service to one another and our neighbors becomes vital, because that is where the kingdom of God is revealed. So this Advent season, grab ahold of God's promise to be with you - in all things - and even in a season of "social distancing," remain connected to God and to his people.

As we look ahead to December, here are a few things to keep in mind. First, the Church Council will be meeting early in the month to continue to monitor and make decisions regarding gathering for worship on-campus or remote only. We will always have the live stream going, which is critical especially for those who should not venture out into social settings, like church. So if that is you, please be blessed in staying at home and joining us online. At this point in time, I am not sure what will happen on Christmas Eve. If we would be on-campus, I would anticipate going to two services on Christmas Eve to help with social distancing. But we may not be able to meet on-campus, and we will then provide a meaningful experience online for you and your family connected together online. We will do our best to get word out as soon as possible so please keep an eye on our Facebook page and website for details.

In the meantime, there is much ministry that occurs without being seen. I am so grateful to serve a congregation where members reach out to one another. I have found that, when I get down because of the isolation the pandemic produces, the best way to come out of that is by connecting with someone else and serving them in whatever way I can. It feels counterintuitive to what I feel, but God is able to rejuvenate my own spirit when he uses me to minister to someone else. I think you will find it to be similar for you, also. Remember, "God with us" may be most realistically experienced by you being with someone else in the name of Jesus Christ.

COUNCIL MINUTES
November 4, 2020**

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on November 4, 2020 at 7:00 pm in Fellowship Hall, abiding by the social distancing guidelines and by Zoom meeting. Members present were: Todd Horning, Brian Werner, Chantel Neperman, and Pastor Todd onsite; and Char and Sharon joined by Zoom meeting. Absent were Brian Kletscher, Kris Vollmer, Cory Blomgren and Jocelyn Geske.

President Horning called the meeting to order. Pastor Todd led the group in devotions and prayer.

Secretary's report – emailed to council. On a motion by Chantel, second by Brian W, the regular monthly minutes for October 2020 were approved. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report – Checking Balance \$800.56. Savings Balance of \$24,282.15. The parking lot balance is \$14,514.84. Chantel reported the Forgiveness part of the PPP loan has been submitted and she has also completed the County CARES Act information. On a motion by Brian W, second by Sharon the report was approved.

Education: No report.

Worship & Music: No meeting. Char reported new Acolyte robe sashes have been ordered.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: Kris submitted a written report to the council. She stated there has been increased giving for missions for RRC. The team was able to purchase several new graphing calculators for the math classes. Great job!

Property: Brian reported the team will be trimming the trees by the Parking lot before winter. The council would like to give a big thank you to Julie Senst for raking the lawn and cleaning up around the parsonage. We sure appreciate you, Julie!!

Old Business: Again, we discussed the opening for an organist. Pastor Todd will be getting an ad in the local papers. The new video system is still a work in progress. There are problems with the audio feed from the old system to the balcony jack that needs to be addressed prior to rolling it out. Onsite worship and Sunday School will start on November 8th; Confirmation classes go onsite November 11th. Due to RRC going remote learning the week after Thanksgiving, it was determined we will have online worship on November 29th and online Confirmation on December 2nd.

New Business: Chantel presented the preliminary 2021 budget to the council and asked everyone to look it over and we will amend/approve it at the December meeting. Char suggested we perform annual performance reviews with the staff at OSLC. This will be reviewed further with the Council.

Pastor's Report – Pastor Todd presented a written report of his monthly activities. He performed 2 funerals and made numerous visits and phone calls to members and within the community. He was in attendance at Confirmation Classes, Board of Ed, Church Council, online LCMC Annual Meeting, Online Here We Stand Conference, LCMC Augustana District Ambassadors' online meeting and First Communion Training with the 6th graders. He was also able to attend an RRC Jr High football game.


With no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Chantel, second by Brian W.
