President Smith called the meeting to order and led the group in prayer.

Secretary's Report: October council minutes were read by Susan. Mike moved, and Kevin seconded to approve as read. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: John, in Kari's absence, reported the October checking balance of \$30,118.16, and savings balance of \$45,866.36. On a motion by Cory, seconded by Misty, the report was approved. Motion carried.

Education: Prek-6<sup>th</sup> grade will sing during Nov 6<sup>th</sup> worship. Prayer Partners is Nov 13th and Christmas program rehearsal will begin Nov 20<sup>th</sup> for the Children's Christmas program, which will be held Dec 18<sup>th</sup>.

Worship & Music: There was a recommendation to have the pianos tuned. Janice will check on options.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: No report.

Property: Jess Bittner will begin installing flooring in the parsonage on Nov 15<sup>th</sup>. There are shrubs in the church landscaping that may need to be replaced in the spring. A suggestion was made to begin updating décor around the church building.






#### NOMINATING TEAM

The members of the Nominating Team for this year are: Cory Blomgren, Misty Willhite, & Mike Vollmer.




