Your leadership is strong; the congregation is in a place of unity; and the Holy Spirit continues to move in and through us as we love one another and serve those around us. <u>Education</u>: Wendy was present on behalf of the Board of Education to give a brief overview of the board's responsibilities, and the need for additional members of the congregation to serve.

Worship & Music: No report.

<u>Life, Growth & Stewardship</u>: Kris presented on Lenten meals and meeting preparations.

Property: No report.

Old Business: There was a discussion on wish list items to add for the upcoming year. Discussion was had on new sound proof dividers with windows for Fellowship Hall.

New Business: Nominations were discussed, and Chantel presented 2022 budget for review. John moved to approve the budget to present at the Annual Meeting. Kevin seconded it. Motion passes.







New Pew Bibles!

The leadership of Our Savior's has recommended the Contemporary English Version of the Bible for church wide use. Starting after Easter back in April, members of the Church Council, Worship & Music team, and the Board of Education have been comparing 3 versions to consider:

- ESV (English Standard Version) closest to the NRSV which we have previously used; the ESV is the version used in the new ReClaim hymnal, Confirmation and Sunday School curriculum;
- NIV (New International Version) close to ESV with more contemporary wording and grammar;
- CEV (Contemporary English Version) written in more current wording and grammar;



We are now launching the effort to pay for these new Pew Bibles in a similar way that funds were raised for the new hymnals. Please use this form to contribute to the Pew Bibles. Soon you will be able to look up the scripture passages during our worship services with a Pew Bible near you.

So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ (Romans 10:17).




