Dear Congregation,

Pastor Todd opened with devotions.

President Kletscher called the meeting to order.

<u>Secretary's report</u> – emailed to council. On a motion by Todd, second by Char, the minutes were approved.

<u>Treasurers Report</u> – Checking Balance \$8,840.53. Savings Balance of \$24,266.01. On a motion by Sharon, second by Todd, the report was approved. The parking lot fund has a balance of \$13,174.50 at the present time.

Education: No meeting.

The Christmas Program was a great success!

Worship & Music: No meeting. The media list is complete.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: No report.

<u>Property</u>: The altar lights have been replaced and look great! The Parking Lot poster is ready to hang up to mark our fundraising progress. There were a number of complaints about the snow removal on the parking lot that will be addressed.

Old Business: The 2020 Budget was reviewed by the council. On a motion by Todd; second by Brian W, the budget was approved as submitted. Motion carried. Thank you to Jodi and Leah for your 10 and 13 years of amazing service to our youth and to the Board of Ed.


Additional members will be stepping down in Dec 2020, so working ahead to fill those spots! The second thanks to them for building in a transition period.





Parking Lot Update:

OSLC Members—

Our Savior's parking lot resurfacing is planned to take place the summer of 2020. As you know, after looking at the maintenance expense of asphalt ,your church council has discussed moving forward with the removal of asphalt and laying concrete for its new surface at an estimated cost of \$140,000.

This capital project will, of course, be a major investment for our church and we will not be able to pull it off without the support of the entire congregation. When the new council leadership takes over in February, they will be preparing a fundraising push so that we can have the majority of the funds raised by late spring/early summer 2020.

We ask that each of you prayerfully plan your contribution for the parking lot resurfacing project. You may begin your contributions at any time; the trust committee is holding the gifts in a separate fund—so far just over \$12,000 has been given. Please mark your gift "Parking Lot Fund" so that we can be sure it gets to the right place. Many thanks for helping to maintain Our Savior's Church.




