The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

John 10:10

What if I told you that there was a supplement that would transform your life: it would give you a longer and happier life; it would make your family life richer and more fulfilling; it would make you wiser and more discerning, as well as, healthier and more energetic. Add to those positive benefits that, initially, you didn't have to buy the pill. You could take the supplement and then donate the amount of money and time you thought the supplement was worth.

Sadly, there is no such pill. However there is a single habit or practice that provides all those benefits and many more. It is the habit of an active religious faith. Rodney Stark, a leading Sociologist at Baylor University, in his book America's Blessings: How Religion Benefits Everyone, Including Atheists has gathered scores of scientific studies that point to the positive benefits of religious faith. Here is a very partial list of the benefits:

- Enjoy superior mental health are deemed happier, less neurotic, and far less likely to commit suicide
- Enjoy superior physical health have an average life expectancy more than seven years longer than that of the irreligious
- Read more than their irreligious friends and neighbors
- More apt to marry, less likely to divorce, and report higher degrees of satisfaction with their spouse.
- Religious husbands are far less likely to abuse their wives or children.
- Religious fathers are more likely to be involved in youth-related activities such as coaching sports teams or leading Scout troops, etc.
- Religious couples enjoy their sex lives more. They are also far less likely to have an affair.
- Religious students perform better on standardized achievement tests, are far less likely to drop out of school, obtain better jobs upon graduation, and are far less likely to be on unemployment.

All of these stats prove that what the Bible's counsel is indeed wise counsel. Jesus' promise that a relationship with him leads to a fuller, healthier life is genuine.

We have something to share. At times we Christians have been shy about sharing our faith. We are afraid that we might be perceived as rude or fanatical. However, if we had some health supplement that would give us the above-mentioned benefits, we would certainly be telling others. In this time, when many seem to be drifting away from the faith, we need to share our faith and point to the apparent benefits of a life of faith. You might start by sharing this article with someone you know who is not a person of faith or is not actively participating in their faith.

### **OUR SAVIOR'S LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES** June 7, 2023

These minutes were recorded at the last council meeting and will be approved at the next meeting.

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on June 7, 2023 in fellowship hall. Members present were Kevin Graff, Kari Halter, Deb Furth, John Smith, Janice Werner, Steve Halter, Courtney Thram, Kurt Willhite, Brian Benedict, and Pastor Carl Billings.

President Graff called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and Pastor Carl led the group in prayer.

Secretary's Report: May council minutes were read by Deb. Corrections to secretary's report - Pastor prefers to use the CEV version of the Bible, not the ESV. Typo error in call committee report corrected the word "form" to the word "from". John moved and Steve seconded to approve the minutes as corrected. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Kari reported the May checking balance of \$40,427.10 and savings balance of \$45,921.05. On a motion by Kurt and seconded by Courtney, the report was approved. Motion carried. There was a question about funds available in trust for room dividers in fellowship hall. Kevin will check with Rich on this matter.

Pastor's Report: Pastor had two baptisms; communion services at Valley View in May and June; six personal communions; met with Life, Growth & Stewardship to put together a visitation team; attended a class on intentional interim ministry; baccalaureate. He will be attending a meeting of area churches to discuss pastoral vacancies on Wednesday, June 28 at St. Paul's in Springfield. Pastor Randy Freune will head up this meeting. Pastor asked for some people to accompany him to this meeting. Bible, Burgers and Brews starts this week, Thursday, June 8 at 7:10 PM. The theme will be Re-creation. Pastor's schedule for June in Lamberton: here June 7 - 18, June 22-24, June 28-July 2. He has also been asked to lead a trip to the Holy Land, Egypt, and Greece June 22-July 1, 2024. He shared information about this trip and if anyone is interested in attending, they can contact him. Pastor should submit mileage for visits and class on interim ministry reimbursements.

### **Committee Reports**

Education: Courtney reported VBS is ready to start on Sunday, June 11 through Thursday, June 15 from 6 to 8 PM. Courtney also asked if there was a schedule for defogging the church basement for bugs as there are quite a few spiders and bugs down there. She was directed to try to get that done when there is no heat or air conditioning being used.

Worship and Music: Janice reported no meeting and she will continue to look into a new refrigerator for the altar guild room.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: Kurt reported they met on June 1. They discussed care teams and names of people to contact to serve on the teams. Lenten meals went well and plans are to do it again next year. The Welcome packet is finalized and some have been put in the city office and in the entry of the church. The first Sound Bites were put in the last newsletter. They discussed mission emphasis for months coming. The ice cream social will be July 19, 2023 form 5 to 7 PM. Kurt is facilitating this event and will look for volunteers to help. Rally Day will be September 10, 2023.

Property: Brian reported that he had talked to Joan Blomgren about the divider at the school. She recommended that the dividers go all the way to the

recommended that the dividers go all the way to the ceiling for noise cancellation. A discussion of the future of this project and the needs we have for that followed.

Pastor Steve Walswick visit June 24 & 25: Pastor and his family will arrive on Saturday, June 24 and meet first with Pastor Carl. Members of the call committee and council will show them the parsonage and take them out to supper in Revere and Pastor Steve will conduct the service on Sunday, June 25. Pastor Carl listed some concerns about some light bulbs at the parsonage. His wife sewed some simple drapes for one of the bedrooms to block incoming drapes for one of the bedrooms to block incoming sunlight. John moved to proceed with a background check on Pastor Walswick as part of the call process. Kurt seconded. Motion carried. Drone Class using parking lot: Leonard Runck asked if the Red Rock Central drone class could use our church parking lot. Council members were contacted through a group text and Ok'd this request.

<u>A/C nests resolved</u>: A family of birds that built a nest in the air conditioner in the pastor's office window was removed. In the future, some better air condition covers should be made.
