OUR SAVIOR'S LUTHERAN CHURCH **COUNCIL MINUTES** June 5, 2024

These minutes were recorded at the last council meeting and will be approved at the next meeting.

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on Wednesday, June 5, 2024 in the fellowship hall. Members present were Kari Halter, Courtney Thram, Sharon Vollmer, Chad Coulter, Steve Halter, Pastor Steve Walswik, Brian Benedict, Kris Vollmer, and Kevin Graff. Absent: Deb Furth. President Halter called the meeting to order at 7:03pm and Pastor Steve led the group in prayer.

Secretary's Report: May minutes were read by Kris Vollmer in the absence of Deb Furth, Secretary. Sharon motioned and Chad seconded to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Kari reported the May checking balance of \$22,137.68 and savings balance of \$66,260.91. Kevin motioned and Courtney seconded to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Steve has discovered the blue song books used in the recent past and has requested that we use them on Sundays for some of our music. Council approved. Sharon will look in to having them rebound or having the covers laminated to increase resistance to wear. Pastor will be presiding at the graveside service for Bill Harnack on Wednesday, June 12. Bill's funeral will be in Wells, MN with burial in Lamberton. Pastor would like to meet with the care team soon after having information shared in the next newsletter. This meeting will follow a church service. He has been making home visits to members of our church and the community.

Committee Reports

Education: No meeting. VBS will be held June 9-13^{tn}.

Worship and Music: No meeting. The planned dedication for the new piano was not held due to scheduling conflicts. This will be done in the future. Bibles, Burgers, & Brew will begin this week. Pastor has been planning with local clergy and Kris has been organizing pianists.

Worship and Music continued: An opportunity to host "The Rescue Tour" group on August 8th has been made available to the group. Plans are underway to host them and on a motion by Sharon and seconded by Chad, motion carried to support the group with a donation of \$300 for the Shepherd's Canyon Retreat ministry supported by this group. A free will offering will also be collected the evening of their program. Pastor requested to contact Erica Varco from the Table Ministry, to invite her to lead one of the BB&B evenings. Council approved and Pastor will check on her availability.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: Meeting to be held Monday, June 10th. The May mission emphasis was on Bible Camp Scholarships, \$2835 was donated. Thank you to our members who supported this worthy mission. Camperships will be given out based on number of applicants. Parents need to contact the church office asap. The Ice Cream Social is scheduled for July 17th.

Property: Another leak has been found in the boiler. The plan is to isolate the leak and parts have been ordered to fix it. Someone is dumping personal garbage in the church dumpster, person was spotted but unknown identity. Please report if you see this happening. The courtyard has been spruced up. Grass will be reseeded near the front entrance. AC covers need to be removed from the offices.

Old Business:

Curtains/Dividers: Two estimates have been received starting at \$200,000 and going much higher. Due to the cost of the project it is being tabled as not feasible at this time. Council feels there are other upcoming projects that are more important.

Pew Bibles: Pastor reports they have been ordered and will be here in about 2 weeks.

New Business:


July Meeting date: Meeting will be held on Monday, July 1st at 7pm because of the July 3rd proximity to the July 4th holiday.

Bibles, Burgers, & Brew will host Special Guests, Gospel Concert Musicians, on August 8th @ 7:10pm at the Lamberton American Legion.




