### "So, what are you giving up for Lent?"

It's a question Christians ask each other this time of year. Lent is a 40 day season leading up to Easter Sunday that begins on Ash Wednesday. Now, if you're counting, there are actually 46 days from Ash Wednesday to Holy Saturday (the day before Easter Sunday). Well, Lent is considered a 40-day season as the Sundays do not figure into the total; Sundays are a smaller feast day to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus. So, Lent is a season when Christians often "give something up" during those 40 days.

Giving something up for Lent, however, doesn't make God love you any more than he does already - He loves you completely now in Christ Jesus! We do give something up, if we choose to, to better focus our heart, mind and body on the suffering of our Lord Jesus and upon his death on a cross - all leading up to the joyous glory of resurrection Easter Sunday!

So, what might you give up this season of Lent? If you so desire, give up something that you don't want to give up - that will give its absence a stronger focus on what Christ Jesus did for you in his suffering and death. I do not need to make a list of common things to give up; you know what it is for you that will make the most impact. Just be honest with yourself, take a deep breath, and commit to giving it up for Lent.

For all of us, whatever we do for Lent, I invite you to make the extra effort and invest the extra time to be part of our Lenten meals and services. They begin on Ash Wednesday, February 26. Come to the sanctuary early that day if you wish to wear ashes on your forehead at work, school or home. I will be in in the sanctuary from 7-9am for any who wish to have ashes placed on their foreheads. Weekly Lenten meals on Wednesdays begin that evening also, followed by 30-minute Lenten Services where we will focus on what Jesus' death and resurrection mean in our lives today.

Whatever you do, remember Who it is that truly gave something up - for you - Jesus Christ:

In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross! Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2:5-11)

On a motion by Brian K, second by Todd, Chantel will need to be added to the Accounts at First Security Bank and Bridget will be removed. Motion carried. Chantel will take care of this item ASAP.

<u>Education</u>: Met on January 19<sup>th</sup>. Discussed the Christmas program, Sunday School, Prayer Partners, Worship Notes, Memory Work and Confirmation. Prayer Partners meet on February 9<sup>th</sup>. There is a Confirmation retreat March 6-8 at Luthercrest near Alexandria.

Worship & Music: No meeting. Molly stated the WM team could use more members.

<u>Life, Growth & Stewardship</u>: No meeting. The team is working on Lenten Meals.

Property: Sam Furth has joined the Property Team. Work is still being done on the parking lot fundraiser. There are a number of items that need to be completed in the church to satisfy the Insurance company requirements.

Old Business: Brian W. updated the Council on the items that need to be completed for the Insurance Company. They are as follows: Emergency light; Panic bar on the North Door; and secure all TVs on carts. These items will be done ASAP. The Leadership Gathering scheduled for February 9<sup>th</sup> at the Parsonage has been cancelled due to Pastor's illness. We hope to reschedule in the near future.

New Business: No new business.


Motion by Chantel to adjourn, second by Cory. Motion carried.



Mary Jo served lunch.






