OUR SAVIOR'S LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES April 6, 2022

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on April 5, 2023 in the church library. Members present were Kevin Graff, Kari Halter, Deb Furth, John Smith, Janice Werner, Kurt Willhite, Courtney Thram, Steve Halter and Brian Benedict. Pastor Carl joined us via computer. Char Graff attended the meeting and facilitated the technology to have Pastor Carl with us.

President Graff called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM and Pastor Carl led the group in prayer.

Secretary's Report: January council minutes were read by Deb. Kurt moved and Kari seconded to approve as read. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Kari reported the March checking balance of \$43,118.03 and savings balance of \$45,921.05. On a motion by John and seconded by Steve, the report was approved. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Carl reported that he had completed visitations and administered communion to OSL members at Valley View Manor. Council directed Pastor to also visit OSL members in Springfield and Redwood Falls, which he is happy to do. He has been asked to do a service the first Friday of the month at Valley View and he will do that. He received a call to do a wedding the summer of 2024 at Our Savior's. He is happy to do the counseling and the wedding, after meeting with the couple to determine a good connection with them. He also mentioned how enjoyable it has been to work with Pastor Mike teaching the confirmation classes.

Committee Reports

Education: Courtney reported VBS will be Sunday, June 10- Thursday, June 15 2023. They are looking at the curriculum from Pastor Carl's previous parish or one we have from the past as a possibility for this year's VBS.

First communion for 5th graders will be Sunday, May 14, 2023. There will be discussion and instructions for first communion on Sunday April 30, 2023, for 5th grade students and at least one parent during Sunday School class on that day.

Confirmation classes are back to the normal time beginning April 12, 2023.

There are 6 students eligible for confirmation and the education committee recommends all to be confirmed. Steve H moved to approve all eligible students be confirmed on May 7, 2023. Janice W seconded. Motion carried.

A few questions were asked about who pays for summer camperships. In the past, Luther League contributed and it was suggested that OSL would also contribute to the cost for students wanting to attend summer Bible camps.

Worship and Music: Janice reported that they purchased a microphone for Pastor. They will meet Thursday, April 13, 2023.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: Kurt reported that the committee met on March 13, 2023. They set up a meeting with Pastor Billings to discuss congregational caregiving.

They have developed a welcome brochure to have available in the Narthex and somewhere within the city of Lamberton. Pastor Billings recommended we have pictures of some of the youth programs on the brochure, as he feels we have a strong program in that area.

Lenten meals had less attendance than in previous years. Mindi Hesse and Misty Willhite prepared the meals with OSL members assisting in serving and cleaning up. Looking into possibly getting some financial assistance through Thrivent for the meals. A gift for The Table Ministry was tabled until the next New members to the committee are Bridget Arkell and Diane Nalley.

Since our youth group doesn't have a mission trip planned for 2023, a discussion will be held at the next meeting as to where to allocate mission monies in place of that.

The ice cream social is set for July 19, 2023. A plan to add some "sound bites" to the newsletter encouraging members to use their talents where applicable, is being developed.


RRC Baccalaureate Service

Your Voice Is Needed!




