#### OUR SAVIOR'S LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES April 3, 2024 Confirmation interviews were held April 3 and the Board of Education has made a recommendation to the council that the following students be confirmed

# These minutes were recorded at the last council meeting and will be approved at the next meeting.

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on Wednesday, April 3, 2024 in fellowship hall. Members present were Kevin Graff, Deb Furth, Sharon Vollmer, Steve Halter, Chad Coulter, Kari Halter, Brian Benedict, Kris Vollmer, Courtney Thram and Pastor Steve Walswick.

President Halter called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM and Pastor Steve led the group in prayer.

<u>Secretary's Report</u>: March minutes were read by Deb. Kevin moved and Kari seconded to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Kari reported the January checking balance of \$34,268.16 and savings balance of \$66,260.91. On a motion by Sharon and seconded by Courtney, the treasurer's report was approved.

#### Pastor's Report:

Pastor Steve would like to attend the 2024 Annual Augustana District Convention on Saturday, April 27, 2024 at Mount Carmel near Alexandria at a cost of \$60. Kevin moved to send Pastor to the conference. Courtney seconded. Motion carried. Pastor Steve received a call from Pastor Carl Billings asking for any council members available, to meet for lunch on May 2 with a representative from Tartu Academy, one of our mission donations last year.

#### **Committee Reports**

<u>Education</u>: Courtney reported that our last Sunday School session for this year is May 12. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade class will receive their acolyte training that day so they can begin acolyting over the summer. Memory work certificates will be handed out in church on April 28 and during Sunday School time on May 12. First communion is set for April 14 during regular church service. The 5<sup>th</sup> graders and their parents will receive instruction during Sunday School on April 7. Students receiving First Communion this year are Chloe Coners, Kylee Leonard, Grifyn Redman and Bentley Werner. Confirmation will take place at 10 AM on May 5. There will be no Sunday School that day. Confirmation interviews were held April 3 and the Board of Education has made a recommendation to the council that the following students be confirmed on May 5, 2024: Braylon Bedner, Jadyn Beranek, Treyton Knutson, Sophie Paplow, Kysha Wani, Marshal Willhite and Paige Wondercheck. Kevin moved to confirm those students recommended by the education committee. Kris seconded. Motion carried. VBS is set for June 9-13, 2024. Kids from the community will be invited to join us. VBS is for students entering kindergarten through finishing 6th grade. Volunteers will be needed for VBS. A discussion was held about what we can do, as a congregation, to provide financial assistance for students to attend Bible camp. Inserts will be placed in the bulletin for scholarship or campership donations.

<u>Life, Growth & Stewardship</u>: Kris reported LGS committee will meet Sunday, April 7, after church. Lenten meals went well. The committee will be deciding where mission endowments will go.

<u>Pew Bibles:</u> Pastor Steve will leave a copy of the Bible to be ordered with Nicole in the office so that people can look at it if they are interested in ordering. Deadline for ordering is April 15, 2024.

<u>Bibles, Burgers and Brew</u> – Kris and Mike Vollmer have met with Pastor Steve and put a plan in place for this to happen again this summer.
