When I first became a pastor, in preparation for All Saints Day, which is customarily the first Sunday in November, I was struggling to find an appropriate hymn. One of my pastor friends said, "Well that's easy, you should sing 'For all the saints,' number 275 in our hymnal." I felt a little bit guilty because I was unfamiliar with the song at the time. Since then I have grown to appreciate this and many other hymns very much.

I wonder, has anyone ever called you a saint before? Most of us, if we're being honest, seldom feel like a saint. But did you know that this is the Apostle Paul's favorite designation for Christians? More than any other term in the New Testament, Paul uses the word "saint" most often to define a Jesus follower. Just for fun, skim through one of your favorite letters of Paul, and we can notice with joy, how often he refers to his audience as saints. Which by implication includes you as a saint! A saint is not given that moniker because they deserve it, but because faith declares that to them. In this way, all of life is for all the saints. Our gift giving God had bestowed on us a continuous stream of gifts, through faith. Therefore, go out and live as a saint today because that's what new life in Christ has achieved for you! Go out today full of hope and joy because Christ has renamed you as a saint by His death, burial, and resurrection!

Our Savior's Lutheran Church Monthly Meeting Minutes October 4, 2023

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on October 4, 2023 in fellowship hall. Members present were Kevin Graff, Deb Furth, John Smith, Janice Werner, Steve Halter, Kurt Willhite, Kari Halter, Brian Benedict, and Pastor Steve Walswick. Absent: Courtney Thram.

President Graff called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and Pastor Steve led the group in prayer.

<u>Secretary's Report</u>: September council minutes were read by Deb. Kari moved and Steve seconded to approve the minutes as read.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Kari reported the August checking balance of \$46,111.65 and savings balance of \$45,980.85. Kari noted that we received a donation from the Methodist church for the Table Ministry speaker at Bibles, Burgers and Brew. It was brought to the attention of the council that we should check on PO box rental to see if non-profits have to pay rent. On a motion by Steve and seconded by Kurt, the treasurer's report was approved. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report:

Pastor Steve reported that the time for 7th and 8th grade confirmation on early dismissal days had to be adjusted to end at 3 PM instead of 3:10 PM to allow student athletes to get to practice on time. The ministerial group met for lunch on Oct. 4. Pastor Steve reported that it was suggested to have our Thanksgiving Eve service on Tuesday, Nov. 21, instead of Tuesday, Nov. 22. The concern was that many families leave on Wednesday for family gatherings, and there is no school on Wednesday, Nov. 22. This year, OSLC hosts the service. Council decided to move the Thanksgiving Eve service to Tuesday, Nov. 21 at 7 PM. OSLC will host the youth WAFER food pick-up on Wednesday, October 25, 2023.

Pastor's Report continued:

Deb will check with Kari Redman to make sure we are covered to host that. Pastor Steve was also asked about Maunday Thursday and Baccalaureate at Our Savior's. Those items will be discussed at a later time. Pastor continues to work on getting in touch with visits to parishioners that can't get out.

<u>Education</u>: Kevin reported, in the absence of Courtney, that they are working on the Christmas program for December 17, 2023

Worship and Music: Janice reported no meeting. We are in need of communion wine. Kurt will take care of that.

<u>Life, Growth & Stewardship</u>: Kurt reported no meeting.

<u>Property:</u> Brian reported he met with Gramstad Lumber regarding the replacement of the door on the Pastor's office. The door will get ordered. Steve asked about some cement that popped up by the SW entrance door of the church. Brian will check into it.

Old Business

Missions ideas: The RRC/WAFER Back Pack program is a possibility for one of our mission emphasis, as well as Tartu Academy, suggested by Pastor Carl.

<u>Parsonage basement shower</u>: Pastor Steve reported it is working well. Kevin will take care of the leaves in the gutters at the parsonage.

Office Chairs: Pastor Steve brought his own chair to use for now and Nicole is happy with hers as is.

<u>Secretary sub pay</u>: John moved and Steve seconded to set the secretary sub pay as suggested. Motion carried

AC covers: AC covers need to be put on before winter. Property committee should look into possible new covers that are lighter weight.






