COUNCIL MINUTES
September 7, 2022**

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on September 7th, 2022 in Fellowship Hall. Members present were: Cory Blomgren, Kevin Graff, Kari Halter, Susan Jeckell, John Smith, Mike Vollmer, Janice Werner, Kurt Willhite and Misty Willhite.

President Smith called the meeting to order and led the group in prayer.

Secretary's Report: August council minutes were read by Susan. Kevin moved, and Cory seconded to approve as read. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Kari reported the August checking balance of \$26,885.42, and savings balance of \$45,860.58. Discussion was had on moving a portion of these funds into a CD. Kari will find out what options are available to us. On a motion by Cory, seconded by Janice, the report was approved. Motion carried.

Education: Rally Sunday will be held Sept 11th with 9:45 Sunday School, 10:45 Church service. Sunday School will end at 10:30am and will coincide with drivers entering the parking lot-please be mindful of this as there may be more students in the parking lot during this transition. Parents of young children will be asked to come into the building for pickup. The Youth Protection Policy was reviewed.

Worship & Music: No report.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: The committee is planning the Rally Sunday potluck meal. They are continuing to work on welcome packets for new guests and members to receive welcoming them into our church. Planned mission envelope recipients for the upcoming year.

Property: The property committee will be meeting with a sales representative on an option for room dividers. A brochure was passed around.

Old Business: Continuously looking to fill Youth Leader roles. Office copier has now been working. No big changes on parsonage update or call committee update at this time.

New Business: Parsonage maintenance; gutters, landscaping and clothesline could use some maintenance going into fall/winter. We will be collecting offering in the pews again, beginning this week with Rally Sunday. Confirmation was discussed as Pastor Mike Stangland has offered to teach classes. Upon a motion by Mike and seconded by Kari, Pastor Mike Stangland will teach confirmation beginning September 14th and up to the full year, based on need. Our Savior's will reimburse his churches for his prep time, teaching time and mileage. Motion passes. With no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Kevin, and Janice second. Motion carried. The next Council Meeting will be October 5th at 7pm. The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

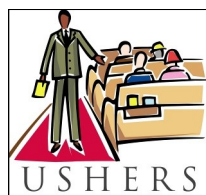

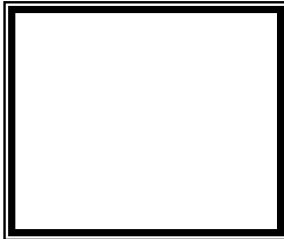

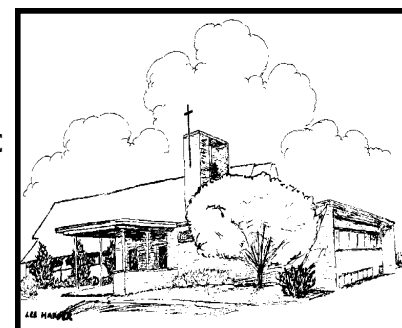
