Education: Rally Sunday will be held Sept 11th with 9:45 Sunday School, 10:45 Church service. Sunday School will end at 10:30am and will coincide with drivers entering the parking lotplease be mindful of this as there may be more students in the parking lot during this transition. Parents of young children will be asked to come into the building for pickup. The Youth Protection Policy was reviewed.

Worship & Music: No report.




Property: The property committee will be meeting with a sales representative on an option for room dividers. A brochure was passed around.




