From the
Pastor's
Desk...

Well, summer is nearly over, school is about to start, and harvest is upon us. What a great time of the year! Yet, I know that we're all still tiptoeing around the Covid-19 pandemic, wondering especially how this will affect school and family. Here is one thing that you can do this month that will be important: pray for our leaders!

The Apostle Paul instructs his young mentee and pastor Timothy this way:

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness (1 Timothy 2:1-2).

Our leaders—local and national; in government, education and health—will need wisdom in guiding us in these days ahead. Locally, pray especially for our School Board and our Health professionals, who will be making decisions throughout this entire school year regarding the health and safety of our children and faculty and staff at our schools.

As a congregation, we are looking to our local school to guide our own gatherings. Here's what I mean. Regarding Sunday School: If there is no on-site school on Friday (due to Covid-19), there will be no Sunday School here. If there is no on-site school on Wednesday, Confirmation will be online that week. We will continue holding on-site worship services on Sundays, but will continue to live stream our services and broadcast them on FM radio for those who would rather not come into the church building. And, sadly, church potlucks will not happen in the near term.

I want to thank you all, the congregation of Our Savior's, for the way in which you are serving one another with your willingness to wear face masks inside the church building and to follow social distancing guidelines. Yes, the "look and feel" of worship gatherings and Christian education is different and, frankly, less than what we want, but your desire to be with one another is possible because of your attitude and actions. Thank you!

This is where the next two verses in 1 Timothy 2 are apropos:

This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth (1 Timothy 2:3-4).

May the Lord Jesus Christ continue to be lifted up among and through us in these strange days.

COUNCIL MINUTES
August 5, 2020**

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on August 5, 2020 at 7:00 pm in Fellowship Hall, abiding by the social distancing guidelines. Members present were: Todd Horning, Cory Blomgren, Brian Kletscher, Sharon Vollmer, Chantel Neperman, Molly Werner, Jocelyn Geske, Brian Werner and Pastor Todd. Absent was Kris Vollmer.

President Horning called the meeting to order. Pastor Todd led the group in devotions and prayer.

Secretary's report – emailed to council. On a motion by Brian K, second by Chantel, the regular monthly minutes for July 2020 were approved. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report – Checking Balance \$23,711.11. Savings Balance of \$24,279.10. The parking lot fund has a balance of \$44,493.15 at the present time. On a motion by Brian K, second by Cory, the report was approved.

Education: The team met on July 7th. VBS will not be held this year. A decision about Sunday School is yet to be made as we will take guidance from Red Rock Central. Confirmation classes will be held either in-person or via online meeting. There are 9 students who have met all the requirements for Confirmation and were presented to the Council. They are: Charles Dammann, Madelyn Geske, Rachel Holman, Josie Horning, Reilly Hubin, Morgan Huffman, Tucker Juhnke, Delaney Willhite and Lindsey Willhite. On a motion by Molly, second by Chantel to approve these young people for Confirmation to be held on August 30, 2020. Motion carried.

Worship & Music: Molly reported that attendance in-house for worship has been ok. Everyone is abiding by the mask and social distancing guidelines. The online presence has been very good.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: No meeting.

Property: The Bat company is coming back as they are still an issue. Brian has secured a garbage container for the parsonage. He will also be erecting Big Truck signs for the parking lot. Shingling of the parsonage and garage will be done yet this summer/fall. Volunteers are welcome.

Old Business: The council discussed the new parking lot next. Brian reported there were 27 volunteers that worked over 485 hours to get this project completed! The Council wants to thank all of you for your hard work! It was also noted that Carroll Distributing has donated the use of the Power Skreeter.

The Board of Ed is working on the Child Protection Policy that will be adopted prior to the start of Sunday School in September.

The re-opening of church was discussed briefly. We will continue handling things as is.

New Business: There needs to be a change of Authorized signers on the Luther League checking account at First Security Bank. On a motion by Sharon, second by Molly we approved Jeannie Horning as new signer, replacing Julie Senst, who will be removed from the account. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report – Pastor Todd presented a written report of his monthly activities. He presided over one Baptism in July. Meetings and special events during the month of July were: Church Council; Board of Ed; LCMC Augustana District Ambassador Zoom meeting; Ordination Credentials Zoom Meeting; Contemporary Service rehearsals; Grad party and numerous visits, emails and phone calls with congregants.

Pastor reported the streaming and projection hardware has been ordered and will be installed ASAP. The internet connection at the church needed to be upgraded to handle the new equipment.

With no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Chantel Neperman, second by Cory Blomgren.

The next Council Meeting will be held on September 9, 2020 at 7:00 pm. *NOTE CHANGE OF DATE.

We will continue to live stream our public worship services even as we look to re-gather again in a safe manner.



September's Mission will be designated to school supplies for Red Rock Central! Yes, we did this in July but we did not have a good response and would like to do better.






