



# Meeting People Where They Are ... Around the Table

Worship on Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings at the bar continues to fill the tables - we are reaching people of all ages. (We had over 200 people on Easter Sunday!) Learning across the generations, around the tables, with our children, youth, people of all ages/stages/seasons has been a step into something different. It is beautiful! Grandparents learning with their

grandchildren. Teens helping with worship. Families doing life together. What is happening around the tables is something sacred. Thank you for helping us set them!

#### Service to Others

Our congregation's heart for mission continues to be at the forefront. Meeting people where they are...in the good, in the hard, in the real life. We meet people on their mountaintops. We are there for them in their vallevs.

2022 has found us making/delivering blankets for Project Warm Up (a local organization housed out of an elementary school that gifts blankets to children that are facing life trials.), serving several meals at The Bishop Dudley House and The Banquet, continuing our support of Hayward Elementary (a low income school without a PTA), visiting our neighborhood nursing home,

partnering with the Volunteers of America, spreading love by doing an afternoon kindness walk, cleaning up garbage in our neighborhoods, and living out what it means to love and serve our neighbors.

#### Celebrating at The Table

Milestones. Sacraments. Celebrations at The Table. Our people are gathering around His Word and His Table. Being offered His free gift of grace. Forgiveness. Love. Acceptance. All of this. For them. We (You + Us) are giving people the opportunity to "do" church and hear His word in a different way. What an honor!

We celebrated our first First Communion at The Table. 19 children received their first communion. 19! WOW! The bar was packed. Tables and hearts were full. The day was joyful!

#### A Note from The Table Ministry continued

9 high school students affirmed their faith at Confirmation during a beautiful worship service in May. The young men and women led worship. Shared their gifts of music and speaking. These kids are incredible. They're wise. They're hopeful. And we are excited for this new chapter in their lives. Our young people have been an example of what a faith community should look like - sharing wisdom and laughter, understanding and prayers. Barriers are broken. Sin is exposed. Meals are eaten. His Word is shared. We are in awe of all we are preventing by providing this safe, consistent place for teens. What a privilege it is to do life with them around the table. We've welcomed two children into God's family with the waters of Holy Baptism. We walk with our community in their grief. We show up in their

sickness. We pray with them in their junk. And celebrate their joys. God is building His church. It is beautiful.

#### Summer at The Table

We spent Mondays around picnic tables at the park hosting weekly "VBS type" days at the park. We welcomed parents, grandparents, older siblings, nannies and kids to experience bible stories in a way that meets them where they are. The Bible came alive for people with everything from Science to sensory, goats to games, projects to parades. Adults connected, kids learned and laughed. Sang songs and had fun

with friends. Our Mondays filled us. They reached our community and weaved faith into their everyday lives. We took our Sunday worship on the road a few times this summer. We worshiped at area lakes, bringing a message and music to campers, new friends, and families at their cabins. It is always a privilege to tell the story of The Table. To tell the story of all that YOUR gifts are doing. Our Wednesday worship was replaced this summer by a Midweek Meeting You. Each month we met for an evening of community, service, and fellowship. We served at The Banquet, we took in a Canaries baseball game, we had a potluck and a night of boating and beach fun at a local lake, we went paddle boarding, and go-cart riding, and spent a day at an Amusement Park. (40+ youth at Valleyfair. WOW!)




