OUR SAVIOR'S LUTHERAN CHURCH **COUNCIL MINUTES** June 4, 2025

These minutes were recorded at the last council meeting and will be approved at the next meeting.

The OSLC Church Council met for its monthly meeting on Wednesday, June 4, 2025 in fellowship hall. Members present were Chad Coulter, Chad Beranek, Kari Halter, Deb Furth, Kris Vollmer, Janice Werner, John Smith, Justtina Erickson and Steve Halter.

President Coulter called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM and Kris led the group in prayer.

Secretary's Report: Chad B moved and Kari seconded to approve the May minutes as presented by Deb through an email. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Kari reported the May checking balance of \$7,792.35 and savings balance of \$61,609.10. On a motion by Steve and seconded by Janice, the treasurer's report was approved.

Committee Reports

Education: Justtina reported they had not met. VBS will be this Sunday, June 8 to Thursday, June 12.

Worship and Music: Janice had no report.

Life, Growth & Stewardship: Kris reported they had met on Monday, June 2. They decided, due to declining attendance, next year, there will only be a Lenten meal on Ash Wednesday. The ice cream social will be Wednesday, July 16. Photos have been submitted and reviewed with the photographer. The directory will be available after it is proofed and approved.

** Property: John reported water has been turned off at the parsonage and a walk through was done. A letter for Jake Grunewald is ready to be signed regarding a driveway to the back of his house from our property.

Old Business:

Care Teams: Tools and communion kits have been distributed to those interested in serving on this team after church on Sunday, June 1, 2025. We could use more people on this group.

Initial plan is to visit once/month and members volunteered where they might be able to visit to nursing homes, home bound and special visits.

Overflow Refresh update: Work has begun on the next phase. The committee will meet again in June to move forward. They received \$787.16 from LGS meal donations.

Boiler: The boiler is here and ready to be installed. Cost has increased slightly since original bid. We are taking donations towards the boiler.

Spring Cleaning: The church cleaning task list has been posted on the bulletin board. Council reviewed the list. We are hoping that members will sign up to complete or assist with a task(s). Supplies are available at the church to complete the tasks. Council/property committee will attempt to get rid of broken, outdated or useless "junk" that has accumulated.

Church Survey: Church surveys have been collected and given to the call committee.

Upcoming church services: Council went through plans for upcoming services. A schedule is being put together for people willing to assist with services. If anyone would like to volunteer to assist with this, please contact Nicole at the church office or any church council member.

Call committee: The following members have agreed to be on the call committee: Vernon Pfarr, Kurt Willhite, Chad Beranek, Grace Guggisberg, Lexi Benedict, Katie Gisch, and Bowan Hesse. These members will be elected at a special congregational meeting following the church service on Sunday, June 8 and installed on June 15.

New Business

Requests for pulpit supply and interim pastor: Requests have been sent to seminaries, LCMC and Augustana district for pulpit supply pastors and an interim pastor for OSLC.

<u>District News:</u> It was brought to council's attention that we are listed on the LCMC website as a part of both the Epiphany and Augustana Districts. It was voted on in January 2019 to join the Augustana district. Kris moved and John seconded to have us removed from the Epiphany District of LCMC, which is not currently active. Motion carried.

A request has been made for a wedding and baptism. Council will look into possibilities for these services.

Endowment proposal for use of Mission Endowment Funds: (Proposal attached): LGS met with Rich Arkell to work on guidelines for this fund. Chad B moved and Steve seconded to accept the proposal submitted by LGS on the use of Mission Endowment Funds. Motion carried.

Highlights of proposal:

- 1) Amount of fund to be used will be 3% of the balance each year on December 31.
- 2) Will set up with Thrivent Financial to occur automatically with funds being deposited into the LGS mission checking account.
- 3) LGS will choose a local or regional recipient of the funds. Funds will be used for missions only and not internally for church projects or needs.






