Information and Protective Services

Beware of "skimmers", not "scammers". Skimmers are devices that thieves place on what looks to be card swipes on gas pumps, ATMs, etc. in order to steal your card information. As we traveled over the holidays, within thirty minutes of using our card at a gas pump, thieves already had a fake card and had attempted to use it in Missouri and Kansas. More reputable gas facilities use cameras and check their pumps daily to ensure that skimmers have not been placed on the pumps. Some of the "older" stations have not switched to the chip technology that prevents skimming. The horizontal readers are ones that accept the new chip technology. Watch for these card readers and newer pumps to decrease your chances for being "skimmed".
