December 21, 1877: Death – Charles Smith: Fourth President of NSA

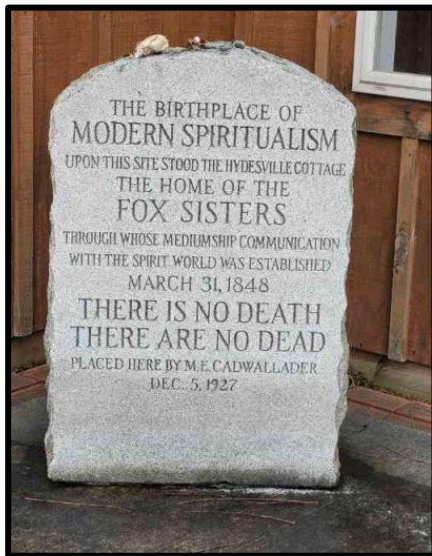

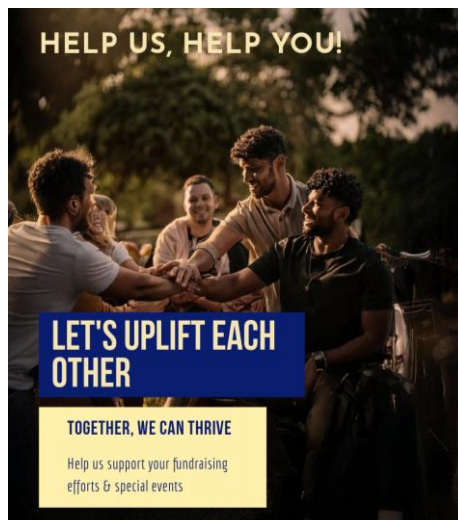
