"Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord!" - Psalm 150:6.


May the joy of autumn and the music of faith fill your hearts this October.

# Children's Education Ministry

Greetings Church Family,

Happy fall Y'all!

Our IGNITE kids and youth program looks a little different this year. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of every month, the youth will meet from 5-6pm at the church (5<sup>th</sup> grade and up). On the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays of every month, we will hold a lesson right after church from 10:45-11:30am for the preschoolers through 4<sup>th</sup> graders. A small snack will be provided for the Sunday morning sessions.

Each Sunday, we have a small children's message of about 3-5 minutes during service for all the children who are in attendance. If this is something you would like to do every so often, please let me know! We would love to have a few new people do a lesson so the kids can get to know a few new faces.



We will be holding our annual indoor Halloween event again this year on Friday, Oct. 31st at 5:30pm, and we are still seeking volunteers! This is a fall festival type event with games, prizes, food, and cider. This event is SO much fun! Not only is it fun for the kids, but the adults have a blast too! We get over 150 people from the community who attend this event and we are able to send home informational packets to families about our church and our programs that we offer. We think it's a great way to get people in the door and to see our friendly faces! To do this, we need volunteers.

We need a couple people to help handout hotdogs, chips, and apple cider. We need people to sit at the tables where small table games will be played to hand out candy. We also need some youth to help with the more active, carnival type games. Oh, and we need donations of candy/fruit snacks/small treats. Please let Beth or I know if you are able to help! Our congregation is always such a huge help with this event...thank you!

We want to continue our tradition with packing shoe boxes for Operation Christmas Child so please donate items if you can. Donated items could include sandals, socks, shirts, hats, sunglasses, and even school supplies such as crayons, markers, pencils, notebooks. Other great items to donate are hygiene items like toothbrushes/combs/hairclips (no liquids), winter wear such as hats/gloves/scarves, jewelry, small stuffed animals, deflated balls with air pumps, and other small toys. Please bring your items to the church office. In November, we will have a night where all the IGNITE kids/youth will box all the goodies up/pray over them and prepare them for shipment, but we need items for the kids to pack up. We love getting the kids involved to teach them about helping others! We'd love it if YOU could join us too!


