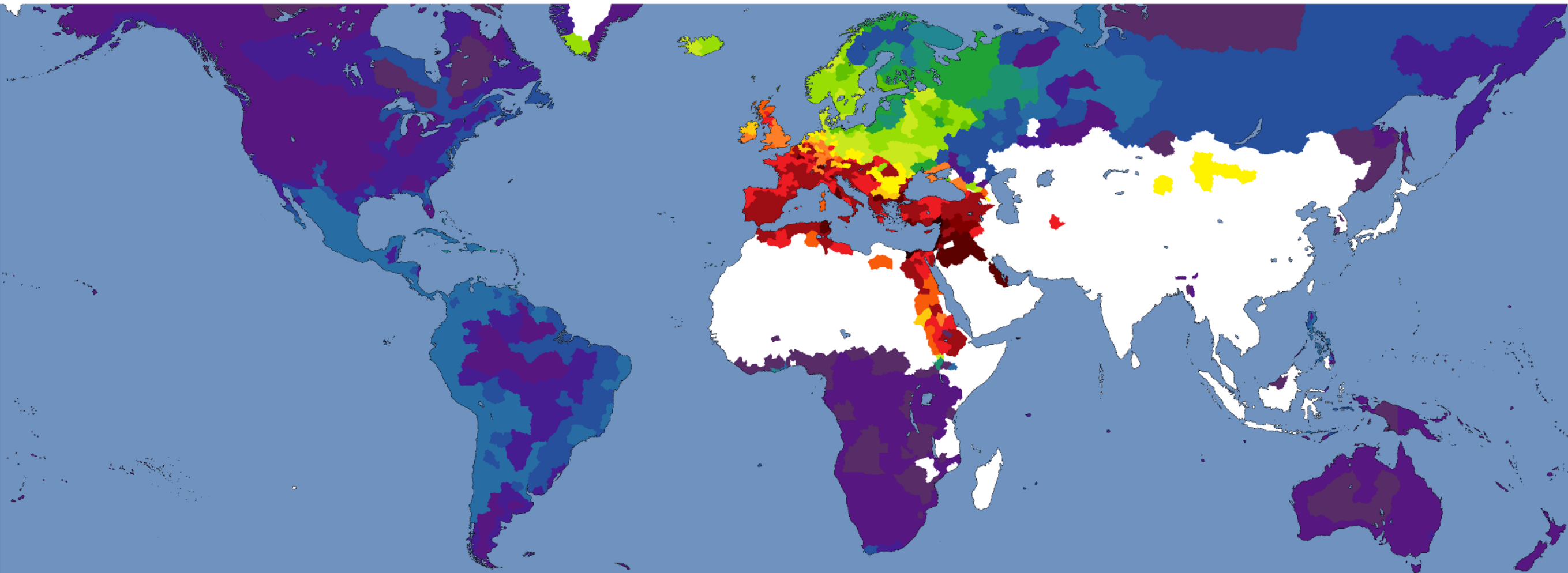




DOMINANT RELIGIONS IN EUROPE, 16TH CENTURY
