General Rules

1. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury, or damage done to or occasioned by, or rising from any animal or article exhibited by him/her.
2. Only boys and girls who are regularly enrolled in public or private schools or home schooled of less than a college level are regularly enrolled members of 4-H, FFA, or Junior FFA in Gray County are eligible to compete in this show. All youth must be deemed eligible under UIL rules. If the student is ineligible under UIL rules, the animal is also ineligible. If a protest is made, it will incur a \$100 protest fee and the protest will be heard by the executive board.
3. All applications for entry must be made by the supervising County Agent or Vocational Instructor on forms furnished by the show committee. These forms will be furnished on application to the secretary and must be received at designated time given by the TOT board. All animals must be in the barn when their class is called.
4. ALL ENTRY FEES CAN BE PAID WITH CREDIT CARD (3% convenience fee), MONEY ORDER, CASHIER CHECK, OR CASH: County and School Checks accepted upon request.
Entry fees as follows:

f. Mini Steers	\$15.00	Buckle to Grand and Reserve Champion
5. 60% of animals exhibited in each division will sell in premium sale. Entrants may sale two highest placing animals. (**Roll up in sale to be informed by secretary. Roll up is available only to entrants who do not have an animal in the sale**). Exhibitors will be allowed to roll one animal up into the sale per exhibitor.
6. WOOD CHIPS ONLY!!! Hay may be used in extreme cold at the TOTJLA President's discretion.
7. NO POWER PLANTS OR HEAT LAMPS ALLOWED IN BARNs, PER TOTJLA PRESIDENT.
8. **VALIDATION** - All species will either be tattooed or tagged according to species. All animals must have a current validation tag in their ear per Texas Validation guidelines.
9. Official weights will be verified by the Superintendents or advisors.
 - a. **Lambs, Goats and Steers: Due Thursday, January 18, 2018 by 4:00 p.m.**
 - b. **Barrows: Due Friday, January 19th, 2018 by 7:00 pm**

DIVISION RULES

Steer Show

1. Classes: Angus, Hereford, Polled Hereford, Shorthorn, Brangus, Santa Gertrudis, ABC, Chianina, Maine, Charolais, Simmental, Limousine and Exotic. If there are other breeds registered they will be placed in with like breed to be determined by Superintendent.
2. No tooth rule.
3. Blow & Show.

Lamb Show

1. Wether and ewe lambs are eligible to show.
2. Lambs must be slick shorn above the knee and hock.
3. Classes: Finewool, Finewool Cross, Medium Wool, Southdown (NO minimum # in Class).
4. No painting, powdering, or artificial coloring.

Goat Show

1. Wether goats and Nannie goats are eligible to show.
2. All Goats must be slick shorn above knee with the exception of does.
3. Classes will be divided by weights.
4. No painting, powdering or artificial coloring.
5. Goats are required to have horns tipped blunt no smaller than a dime.

Swine Show - This will be the show order.

1. Classes: Berkshire, White OPB, Duroc, Hampshire, Spots & Polands, Yorkshire, and Crosses. Any breed with less than 3 entries moves to a similar breed.
2. WATER only may be used to dress barrows. No oil based products.

Heifer Show

1. Registered heifers must be registered in the name of the exhibitor on or before July 1, 2017. Commercial Heifers may be shown and must be tagged.
2. Original registration certificate must be available at check in.
3. No painting, powdering or artificial coloring.
4. Classes: English, Exotic, American and Commercial.
5. No Heifers in Gray County Sale.

Mini Steer Show

1. Steers show according to respected breed association guidelines.
2. Classes: Mini Zebu, Mini Angus, Mini Hereford.
3. No tooth rule.
4. Hair Show
5. Steers must have county validation tag.
6. No Mini Steers in the Gray County Sale.
