General Rules

1. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury, or damage done to or occasioned by, or rising from any animal or article exhibited by him/her.
2. All boys and girls 19 & under in 0-12th grade are eligible to compete in this show. Show is open to the world.
3. **All entries are required by 9:00 am on the day of the show. No pre-entries required.** Each exhibitor can submit a cash only entry on the day of show; it is not required to register through an Ag teacher or county agent. County or Ag teacher entries will still be accepted with proper payment by November 17th, 2018 for Swine and December 17th, 2018 for Sheep, Goats and Cattle. Please mail County or School entries to PO Box 853, Pampa, TX 79066 by entry deadlines (entry form on website www.totjla.com). All other registrations are due along with weight entries and payment at required time for each show. Information on entry forms must be legible or they will not be accepted.
4. Show dates and times.
 - a. Swine will show on Saturday & Sunday, December 1st-2nd, 2018 beginning at 10:00 a.m. Weight card deadline is 9:00 am. (No Exceptions)
 - b. Sheep and Goats will show Saturday, January 5th, 2019 in that order starting at 10:00 a.m. Weight card deadline is 9:00 am. (No Exceptions)
 - c. Heifers and steers will show Sunday, January 6th, 2019 in that order starting at 10:00 a.m. Weight card deadline is 9:00 a.m. (No Exceptions) Steers will not start before 1:00 p.m.
 - d. All animals must be in the barn when their class is called. Once weight cards are submitted, no changes will be made. (No exceptions)
5. Showmanship entries are subject to a \$5.00 entry fee per species with 100% payback to the top two places in each division. Entries due before Grand Champion is named in the species. **Exhibitors must have entries in that species and show their own animals.** Divisions are as follows:
Junior: 0-4th grade Intermediate: 5th-8th grade Senior: 9th- 12th grade
6. Bedding will be available for purchase- wood chips only. Hay may be used in extreme cold at the TOTJLA Show President's discretion.
7. No power plants or heat lamps allowed in the barns. During extreme cold, heaters will be allowed at the discretion of TOTJLA Board.
8. Health paper requirements are that of the Texas Animal Health Commission, which can be found at tahc.state.tx.us.

Division Rules

Cattle Show

Cattle Superintendents- Mel Manhart, Christy Wyant and Joe Coutts

1. \$40 Entry Fee per animal, cash only.
2. Steers classes: 1) American & American Cross 2) English and 3) Exotic Cross.
3. Heifer classes: Breed guidelines will follow: 1) English 2) Exotic and 3) American breeds. Classes to be determined by entries; three or more will determine a breed.
4. Heifers must be registered in their particular breed registry in the sole name of the exhibitor before November 1st, 2018. Heifers must be less than 2 years old.
5. Heifers are shown by birthdate and breed on Registration Papers.

6. No tooth rule.
7. Steers cannot weigh over 5% of weight turned in. All weigh backs: random weigh back at TOTJLA discretion.
8. Blow and Show. (No adhesives, paint, powdering or artificial coloring.)

Sheep Show

Lamb Superintendents- Chris Chisum, Randy Holmes and Justin Taylor

1. \$40 Entry Fee per animal, cash only.
2. Lambs cannot weigh over 5 lbs. of weight turned in. All weigh backs: random weigh back at TOTJLA discretion.
3. Wether and ewe lambs are eligible to show.
4. Lambs must be slick shorn above knee and hock.
5. Classes: Finewool, Finewool Cross, Medium Wool, Southdown and Dorper. Any breed with less than three entries will be rolled to a similar class.
6. No painting, powdering, or artificial coloring.

Swine Show

Swine Superintendents- Mel Manhart, Brent Baten & Sy Brown

1. Entry Fee: \$40 Entry Fee per animal, cash only.
2. Entries for Swine only. Swine cannot weigh over 10 lbs. of weight turned in. All weigh backs: random weigh back at TOTJLA discretion.
3. Classes: Berkshire, Dark Other Pure Breeds, Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, White Other Pure Breeds and Crosses. Any breed with less than three entries will be moved to a similar breed.
4. Water only may be used to dress swine; no oil-based products. (Rule will be enforced)
5. No boars over 100 pounds allowed.

Goat Show

Goat Superintendents- Chris Chisum, Randy Holmes and Justin Taylor

1. Entry Fee: \$40 Entry Fee per animal, cash only.
2. Goats cannot weigh over 5 lbs. of weight turned in. All weigh backs: random weigh back at TOTJLA discretion.
3. Wether and doe goats are eligible to show.
4. Goats must be slick shorn above knee and hock with the exception of does.
5. Classes will be divided by weights.
6. No painting, powdering or artificial coloring.
7. Goats are required to have horns tipped blunt no smaller than a dime.
