Syboes - Spring Onions

Ashet - Oval/Large serving dish

Kebbuck - Whole round of cheese

Hogshead - Barrel usually holding ale

Sappy - Succulent

Mazers - Large drinking bowl

Collops - slices

Partan - Crabs

Bree - Cooking liquid

Parritch - Porridge

Farls - Quarters i.e cut into farls

Tatties - Potatoes

Neeps - Turnips

The one world that had nothing to do with food or cooking was GABERLUNZIES. They were registered beggers.
