General introductions by all members present were made.

Minutes of the Last Meeting: Minutes of the 26 February and 25 March general meetings were read and approved as corrected.

Report of the President: Changes to bylaws that would bring our fiscal year in line with IRS requirements discussed. The advantages of becoming a Member club of AKC vs. our current status as a Licensed club discussed. There will be a Scent Work Trial July 25th – a one day event. Another group plans a trial the week before our event. Linda reported that OCSDC is now certified by AKC for Fast CAT.

Report of the Vice President: Police Dog Fundraiser – AKC to match funding. San Diego Police Department and the American Kennel Club have reached a tentative agreement regarding AKC's requirement for use of their decal on police cruiser for k-9 unit(s). The use of the decal was AKC's requirement in order to receive matching funds towards the goal of supporting purchase of a K-9 and equipment. San Diego PD will not allow use of any decals on police cruisers, but will allow use on a specialized golf cart used for their K-9s. This will clear the way for matching funds from AKC.

Report of the Recording Secretary: Nothing of significance to report.
