At Haysden Country Cattery, we welcome senior cats and understand that older guests may require additional monitoring and consideration during their stay.

For the purpose of boarding, we classify cats aged 10 years and over as elderly.

Our Approach to Senior Cats

- Monitor appetite, toileting and general behaviour daily
- Provide a calm, low-stress environment
- Administer prescribed medication as agreed
- Contact you promptly if we have any concerns

Where veterinary attention is required, we will follow our standard emergency procedures and act in the best interests of your cat.

Important Information

As cats age, their health can decline naturally and sometimes without warning. Even in cats that appear stable prior to boarding, underlying or undiagnosed age-related conditions may be present.

While we provide attentive and experienced care, **Haysden Country Cattery cannot accept responsibility for illness, deterioration or death that occurs as a result of natural age-related causes during the boarding period.**

By signing this policy, you acknowledge and accept the inherent risks associated with boarding an elderly cat.
