

League Code of Conduct & Sanctions

To maintain respect, discipline, and a positive environment across all matches, the following rules and sanctions will apply:

Manager Sending Off (→ 6-point deduction)

A manager may be sent off for:

- Abusive language directed at referees, players, or spectators
 - Threatening or aggressive behavior (verbal or physical)
 - Persistent dissent against referee decisions
 - Unsporting conduct (e.g., deliberately inciting conflict)
 - Entering the field of play without permission in a confrontational manner
 - Failure to control the team leading to repeated misconduct

Parent/Spectator Removal (→ 3-point deduction per adult removed)

A parent or spectator may be removed from the sidelines for:

- Verbal abuse toward referees, players, managers, or other spectators
 - Disruptive behaviour that interferes with the match (shouting, arguing, intimidation)
 - Use of offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate language
 - Aggressive or threatening actions toward anyone present
 - Refusal to comply with referee or league official instructions
 - Encouraging unsporting behaviour from players or other spectators

Enforcement

- Referees and league officials have full authority to enforce these rules.
 - Point deductions will be applied immediately following the incident.
 - Teams are responsible for ensuring managers, parents, and spectators adhere to this code of conduct.
