- Entire community patrol: 6pm; 7pm; 8pm; 9:05pm
- No speeders or reckless drivers observed on Blackberry Dr
- <u>Cherry Blossom Lane</u> A few vehicles parked in the fire lane, however after driving through during the second community patrol, all vehicles would move. Nothing suspicious.
- Park Area No one observed in the park area this shift.
- <u>Citrus Grove Rd</u> A few residents out but nothing outside the usual.
- <u>Pineapple Grove Rd</u> Relatively quiet with some vehicular traffic but nothing of note to report.
- <u>Blackberry Ter</u> Several residents out walking up and down the street, but nothing suspicious observed.
- Nothing of note or suspicious to report. Now that it gets dark earlier I am seeing a lot of completely dark homes. I would recommend some form of lighting for all homes as a form of security and safety.

#### Old Business:

- Updates on ongoing projects
  - Retaining wall near entrance to main park off of Blackberry Dr: Will be done over the winter (weather permitting)
- Any new trees to be planted will be done in the spring

- 15601 Gooseberry Ct trees have been trimmed
- **15711 Cherry Blossom Ct** lower branches have been trimmed, Lee tree service will trim the upper branches
- 15002 Citrus Grove Road request for two trims to be removed will be completed by Lee Tree Service
- Board to meet with Metropolis and review CCOC compliance
- Playground equipment
  - upper and lower- swings need replacement. Jen will contact repair person with the scope needing to be assessed.

# - Paint colors

- ARC is transitioning to white for trims, bannisters etc.. The cream colors are outdated. New windows that are coming in you can't get "off white" without an upcharge. Avoid mismatching white and off-white. Bylaws have the 'off white". That color is outdated and expensive. Many members are using white. HOA will vote to occur in December 2025 Annual meeting.
- <u>Asphalt resealing</u> Steve will talk to O'leary to see when we need to do this; we do need to reseal some of the paths in the forest.

#### **New Business:**

- Discuss 2026 budget:
  - Move \$15k into single family (general) reserve and \$15k townhouse reserve from the operating cash account to keep dues the same (no increase) for next 3 years
  - NOTE: Board voted to approve the budget (Kelly, Steve, Jaimie). Board will send the final budget after this meeting
- Finalize December annual meeting voting procedures
  - Third party or independent party to handle all votes
  - Where to send ballots
- Notes for board: Jaimie will put Kate and Angel into contact to figure out how to streamline process to notify Kate when new residents come into the community

- Are there any rules around leaf clean up?
  - There are rules about length of grass, but none specifically about leaf clean up, but we can send a letter if it looks unkept
- Would it be possible to add a dog pick up sign on the walking path?

- We can look into adding 1-2 trash can and poop bag combo in the community but we'll need to pay a service to come clean out the trash cans. Steve can find out who does it for Park Potomac.
- Has Carlos been paid for snow removal in 2018? (\$1800)
  - Board approved to back pay and Steve will submit the invoice tomorrow.
