## Translucent - God is always with us.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:1

Red - separation from God caused by sin, everyone sins. All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23

## Purple - Jesus died for us.

While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

## White - cleansing and forgiveness
