# C O C O O N

*Here is the knit version of the adorable cocoon that allows baby to feel comfy.  
It is easily knit and has crocheted trim and pompom.*

**Directions are for size 0-3 months.**

**Finished chest:** 26"

**Finished length:** 15", excluding hood

**RED HEART® "Baby Clouds™":**

2 skeins 9621 Smiley

**Circular Knitting Needles:**

9mm [US 13] 16"

**Crochet Hook:** 6.5mm [US K-10½].

Stitch marker, yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 8 sts = 4"; 12 rows = 4" in St st.

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

**Special Abbreviation**

**K1 f&b:** Knit in front and back of same stitch.

### COCOON

#### Body

Cast on 40 sts. Place marker and join, being careful not to twist the sts.

**Round 1:** Knit.

**Round 2:** K2, k1 f&b, k14, k1 f&b, k4, k1 f&b, k14, k1 f&b, k2 – 44 sts.

**Round 3:** Knit.

**Round 4:** K2, k1 f&b, k16, k1 f&b, k4, k1 f&b, k16, k1 f&b, k2 – 48 sts.

**Round 5:** Knit.

**Round 6:** K2, k1 f&b, k18, k1 f&b, k4, k1 f&b, k18, k1 f&b, k2 – 52 sts. Work even in Stockinette st until piece measures 15" from beginning.

#### Hood

**Row 1:** Remove marker and now working in rows, bind off 26 sts at center front, knit to end – 26 sts. Work even in Stockinette st until hood measures 9". Bind off. Fold hood in half along bind off edge and sew together.

#### Hood Trim

**Round 1:** With smaller hook, join yarn with a slip st. Ch 1, sc evenly around, join with a slip st to first sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with a slip st to first sc. Fasten off.

#### Pompom

With crochet hook, ch 10, slip st in first loop of ch to make a loop, [ch 10, slip st in same loop of first ch] 9 times, fasten off. Sew to point of hood. Weave in ends. ●
