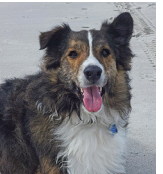

## Playoff Time for the Denver Broncos!



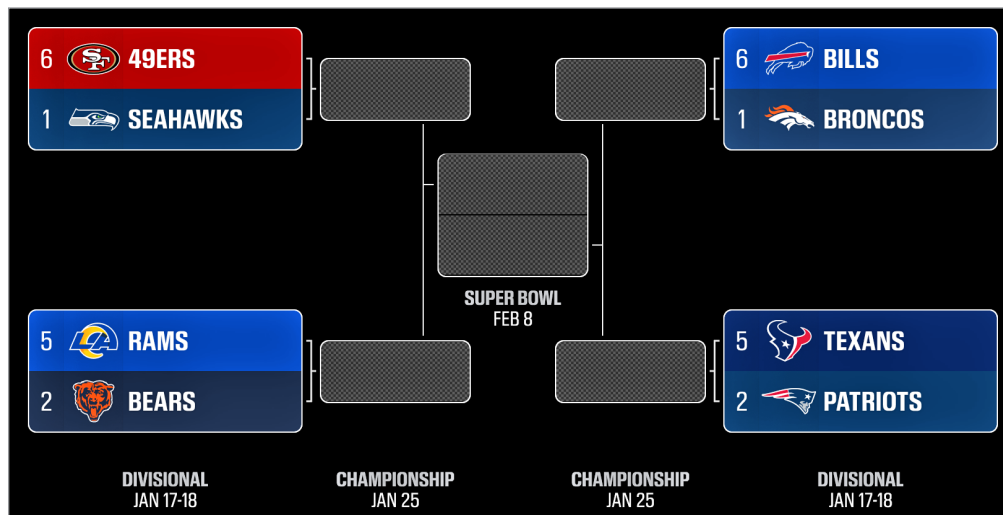
The Broncos return to Empower Field at Mile High on Saturday, hosting a highly anticipated home playoff game as the city rallies behind the team's postseason run. With kickoff set for 2:30 pm, the matchup marks one of the biggest home games in recent years, bringing national attention—and playoff energy—to Denver. Fans are expected to pack the stadium, creating a familiar sea of orange as the Broncos chase another step toward championship glory.



While the focus is firmly on the present, the future is also taking shape. The team is planning a move to the Burnham Yard site in 2031. The second Community Open House will take place

## New Scooters, New Rules: Veo Hits Denver

Denver is rolling into a new chapter for shared mobility, announcing that Veo will replace Lime and Bird as the city's dockless scooter operator. City officials say the switch is intended to improve reliability, safety, and neighborhood coverage while addressing long-standing concerns about sidewalk riding and scooters parked in the wrong places. Veo plans to deploy a refreshed fleet of scooters and e-bikes, paired with stricter parking requirements, improved in-app guidance, and clearer enforcement tools. The transition follows a competitive contracting process and comes as

**veo** City Council updated scooter rules in 2025,



tightening standards around sidewalk use, parking compliance, and equity across neighborhoods. As the rollout begins, riders will see new apps, pricing, and branding. The city says it will closely monitor performance to ensure the program better balances convenience, accessibility, and pedestrian safety.

## Denver Summit's Inaugural Home Match at Empower Field on March 28th

Denver Summit FC will make history this year when it plays its first home match at Mile High. More than 25,000 tickets have already been sold, signaling massive community support for women's professional soccer.



The noon kickoff marks the club's first step toward its 2026 NWSL debut on one of the nation's biggest stages. On December 22nd, Denver City Council approved plans for Summit's future stadium at Santa Fe Yards, securing a permanent home for the club and opportunities for athletes and neighbors. ## Input Phase on RNO Ordinance closes; Report expected in early 2026

Denver City Councilmembers Paul Kashmann and Serena Gonzales-Gutierrez recently announced a milestone updating the city's Registered Neighborhood Organization (RNO) ordinance. From May through September last year, council teams gathered input at 41 events across all council districts and through surveys completed by more than 1,100 residents. Nearly 150 people also participated in neighborhood conversations. The effort aims to broaden participation, reach under-represented communities, and explore ways the city can better support neighborhood groups. The vendor, Radian, is expected to deliver a summary report in the coming weeks. Draft legislation expected in early 2026.



While some RNOs function effectively, others struggle. In the Jefferson Park area, for example, JPUN has virtually disappeared. The group held

only three general meetings in 2025 and skipped annual elections for the third year. According to the JPUN website, no meetings or events are scheduled in 2026. Meanwhile, the Business Improvement District, Jeff Park @ Federal, has filled gaps through several well-attended community events. On the communication front, the neighborhood's newest monthly publication, Jefferson Park Post, has taken the lead on sharing important City updates to the community. City leaders have committed to continued outreach after the report's release. Residents are encouraged to stay engaged and help shape a more inclusive neighborhood system.
