Broncos Country, Welcome Back to Mile High!



The Broncos' regular season kicks off this month with the home opener on Sunday, September 7. Fans can also gather at Mane Street on September 21, when the team faces the Chargers on the road.

This summer was one for the record books at Empower Field. Five major concerts in just 20 days brought in 443,000 guests. Highlights included tour attendance highs for Post Malone and The Weeknd, a recordbreaking 152,000 over two nights with Metallica, and a milestone first NFL stadium show for The Lumineers. Concert announcements for 2026 are expected as early as September.

What's new for fans this season? Concession upgrades, new seats and cupholders in some sections, bottle fillers at water fountains, and a rideshare drop-off near Gate 5. Pre-game fun returns with free family activities at Mane Street and ticketed VIP Tailgate parties at the Mile High Monument.

Neighbors gathered on August 25 for an open house hosted by the Colorado Department of Transportation



to learn about the future of the Speer and 23rd Avenue interchanges. The recommended alternative for 23rd Avenue was the Braid design. This option focuses on safety while

keeping our neighborhoods, businesses, and community resources connected. Highlights include safer ramp connections, sidewalks and bike lanes, and a new signal to help everyone—whether walking, biking, or driving—navigate 23rd Avenue more comfortably. Shaped by input from residents and businesses, the proposal now moves into the NEPA review, the federal process that studies potential environmental and community impacts before construction begins.

RNO Reform Continues with Neighborhood Workshops

Denver City Council continues its effort to update the city's Registered Neighborhood Organization (RNO) ordinance. They're holding a series of in-person Neighborhood Engagement Workshops around the city starting in September. The format will be a facilitated conversation about neighborhoods and related groups in Denver. All are welcome. No experience or expertise necessary. Childcare and light dinner will be provided.

RNOs are groups formed by residents and property owners to share updates, organize events, and work on local projects. But not all RNOs operate the same way. While most people think of them as unique to a statistical neighborhood, the City allows many types of organizations to participate. Boundaries can overlap. There are numerous neighborhoods across the city where multiple RNOs are active. HOAs within a neighborhood can even register. This is especially helpful in situations where an RNO is inactive and no longer shares City updates with its constituents.

The current ordinance guiding RNOs was written in the 1970s and hasn't been updated since. Councilwoman Gonzales-Gutierrez and Councilman Kashmann aim to modernize the rules for equity, accessibility, and transparency.
