




Broncos Share Vision for Burnham Yard Site




The Denver Broncos and the City of Denver drew an estimated 300 residents to their second community open house on February 12th at the La Alma Recreation Center, sharing expanded details for a proposed new stadium at Burnham Yard. Updated plans outline a 150-acre mixed-use district with hotels, housing, restaurants, open space and a retractable-roof stadium targeted to open in 2031.



Designers showcased additional trees and greenery, new pedestrian connections, conceptual road extensions, and flexible parking areas that could later transition into future development. The stadium's western placement is intended to thoughtfully integrate with the neighborhood while creating vibrant new gathering spaces. Construction could begin in 2027, with a community benefits agreement anticipated by early 2027.

Neighborhood Group Receives Official Status from City!

After a year of publishing the Jefferson Park Post to address a long-standing communication gap, the Jefferson Park Neighborhood



Association (JPNA) has been formally recognized by the City of Denver as an official Registered Neighborhood Organization (RNO).

The designation marks an important milestone for residents, creating a recognized structure for community engagement, information sharing, and advocacy on issues shaping the neighborhood's future. Since January 2025, the Post has delivered monthly local news and city updates.

With RNO status secured, JPNA's top priority is leading community conversations about the future of Empower Field at Mile High ahead of the Denver Broncos relocation to Burnham Yard in 2031. The organization will also engage on zoning and land use matters to ensure residents have a clear voice as development proposals move forward.
