New Hotel Scores Points With Neighbors! Courtyard Downtown Denver Stadium Area Opens by Empower Field



The hotel opened doors to their first guests on January 16, 2025. Situated just outside of Downtown Denver, the Courtyard Denver Stadium offers a unique blend of comfort and convenience. With 116 well-appointed rooms, guests will enjoy breathtaking views of Empower Field, the vibrant city skyline and the majestic Rocky Mountains.

One of the highlights of the hotel is the rooftop event space. It offers a 360-degree view from the 6th floor. They can accommodate all kinds of events from weddings and birthday parties to baby showers and private dinners.

Their Bar and Bistro offers a welcoming atmosphere, where guests can unwind with a delicious meal or refreshing drink. As an NFL partner, they'll have games and other fun events on weekends when the season kicks off.

The bar is open for the neighborhood to come have drinks and dinner as well!



Longtime residents of the neighborhood remember this as the former Burger King property. The hotel was designed by Real Architecture and built by Bristlecone Construction. Locals will recognize Real Architecture from several great projects in the Jefferson Park neighborhood including Briar Common and Eliot Center (home to True Eye Care and Curry & Grill).



Rezoning Advances to City Council



The Near Northwest Area Plan worked with community members to create a long-term vision for Chaffee Park, Sunnyside, Highland and Jefferson Park. The plan is currently in the implementation phase.

The first step is a city-sponsored legislative rezoning which Council President Amanda Sandoval is proposing. According to City Planning and Development staff, there were 151 properties in Jefferson Park that will be rezoned.

On January 15, Denver Planning Board held a hearing on the application. The board voted unanimously to recommend approval with conditions to remove 3 properties. One was located in Jefferson Park at 2195 Decatur Street (Zocalo Condominiums).

The application moved to the City's Land Use Committee on January 28. It was approved by a vote of 7-0. Several councilmembers on the committee praised Sandoval for her leadership on this project. It now moves to full council in March.


