Follow the instructions of Father Mike and ushers as you enter and exit the church.

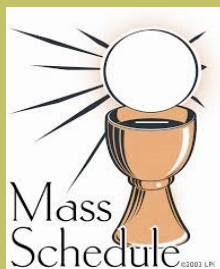
