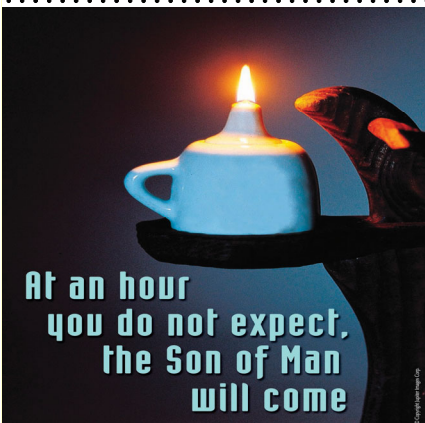

Dear Parishioners,

First of all on behalf of our Sisters and myself would like to thank you and your pastor Fr Isaque Meneses to give us an opportunity to come to you for a Mission Appeal preached on our behalf by our friend Fr Alex J Pacheco. ISHAPREMA-NIKETAN's BRIEF HISTORY. Our little Religious Family, founded in 1961 in a garage, has at its main mission to let our destitute, poor, abandoned or lonely sisters and brothers experience our Heavenly FATHER's personal love and concern for each one of them. To fulfill this mission we have one Home here in Pune and two others in Goa. They are called always Ishaprema-Niketán (Home of God's Love). In them we care for aged women and men, physically handicapped girls and little ones of working mothers from the slums around. We run also sewing and cutting and embroidery classes for girls from the slums to help them uplift themselves financially and socially. Besides other services, we have thrice a week a noon-day meal feeding program for some 200 poor school-going children. Quite a number of non-resident destitute and poor persons and families are also helped by us as much as we are able to in our circumstances, particularly with monthly rations of grains and oil, or in their health problems or difficulties of lodging. It is one of the characteristics of our Homes and of all our services that they are maintained and developed only by alms / voluntary donations. For the last over FIFTY-EIGHT years our FATHER has shown that it is by this way of unbounded trust in Him that He wants our Homes to reveal His love to the poor. People around do help us particularly by providing in kind for the running of the Home. A few do give us also some monetary help, according to their concrete possibilities. But it is not easy for us to collect locally large sums necessary for such greater needs as we have at present. So, when the need is greater or when we have a special project in view, He wants us to trustfully appeal to persons of good will.

Estábamos en contacto con el hablando acerca de las dificultades financieras que estamos experimentando actualmente para llevar a cabo nuestra Ishaprema-Niketán y cumplir con nuestra misión de amor. Como pudieran saber, nuestra Ishaprema-Niketán empezó en una cochera, y ha crecido por la bendición de nuestro Padre, solo con la donación voluntaria que nos han dado personas generosas. Es el servicio de amor dado por nuestra pequeña Familia Religiosa de IVS -SEVIKA (Los Humildes Sirvientes del Amor de Dios) para que nuestros pobres hermanos y hermanas experimenten cada uno de ellos el amor personal de nuestro Padre Celestial. Nosotros cuidamos de los desamparados; abandonados; pobres; de los ancianos hombres e mujeres que viven solos, e igualmente de niñas inválidas. También tenemos un día de guardería para los hijos de madres de los barrios bajos, que trabajan. Para niñas adolescentes de la misma área tenemos clases de costura y bordado, para ayudarlas a levantarse en su posición económica y social. Además tenemos tres veces a la semana un programa de comida para 200 niños pobres que van a la escuela. Según nuestra situación financiera ayudamos también a personas y familias pobres con sus necesidades de salud (medicinas, hospitalización, etc.) y construcción ó reparación de sus pequeñas viviendas. Confiamos queridos Amigos, que en medio de todas sus necesidades personales responderán generosamente, inspirados por el Amor de Dios e su hijo Jesús, a ésta ayuda que pedimos a través de nuestro e su entusiasta Padre Alex Pacheco. Ustedes se convertirán en canales al amor de nuestro Padre Celestial y colaboradores de nuestra misión de Amor. Muy agradecida a cada uno de ustedes e como también a Señor
