SHELTER

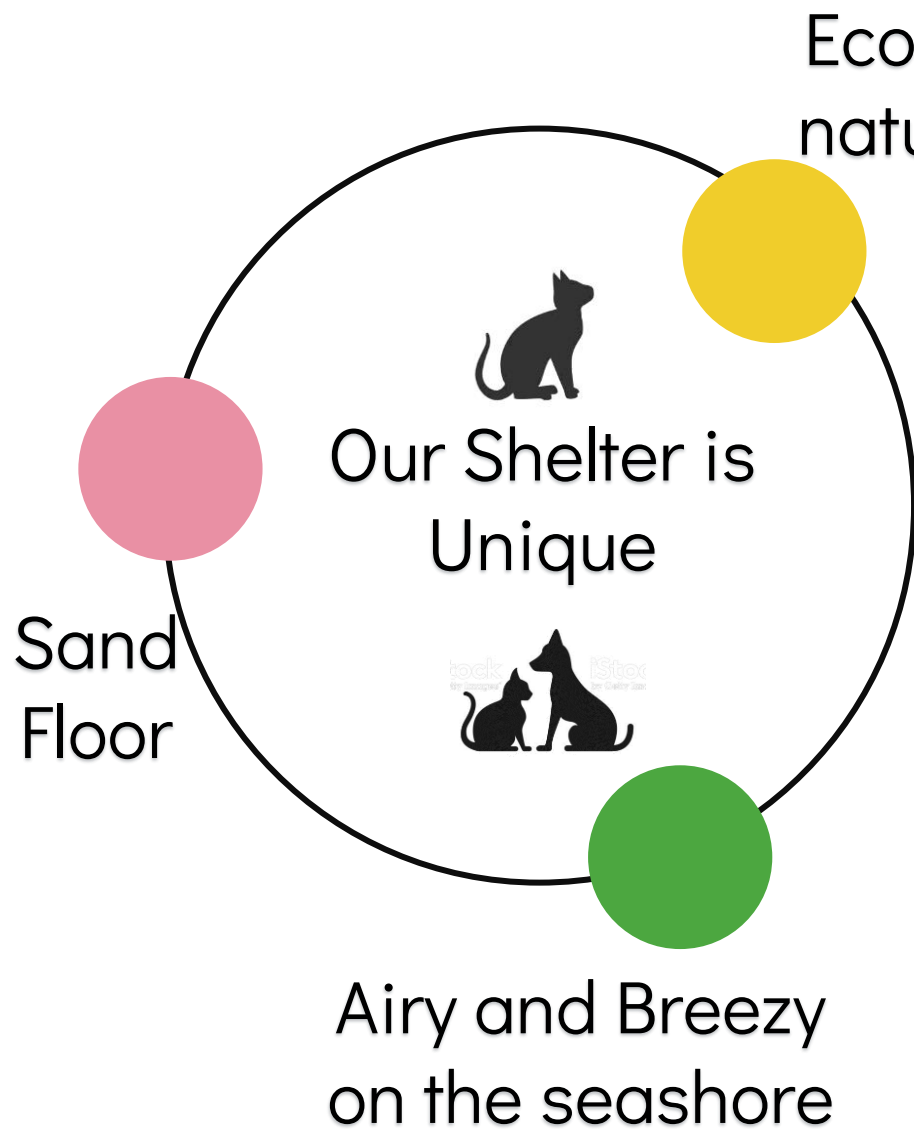
Spacious, airy, and healthy environment on the beach front that houses 220+ animals

Safe havens where they can live out the rest of their days in peace.

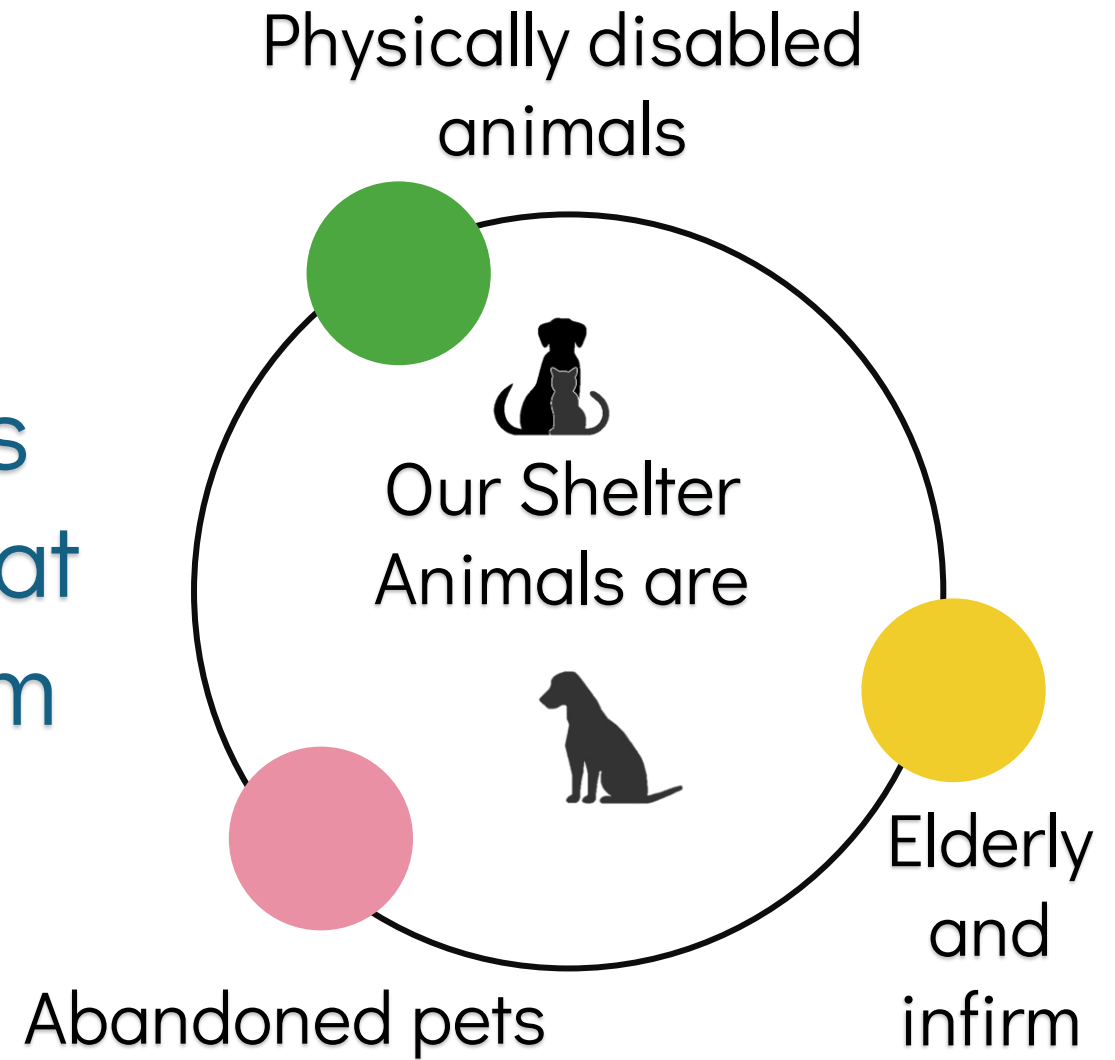
Dogs and cats are too old, or weak, or have a permanent injury like paralysis.

This shelter is one of its kind and has been built using eco friendly materials and the sand floor which is a very comfortable surface and a boon for the injured animals





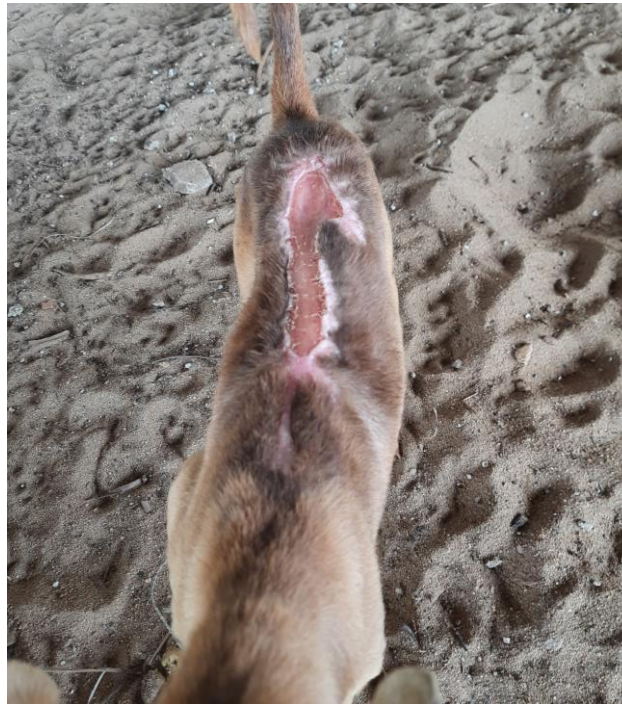
2 Acres Shelter at Kovalam



TREATMENT

We have helped over 2250 animals by taking them to the veterinary treatment at the right time. It is so fulfilling to see these animals recover well and get back to being the happy beings they are.

Limping dogs and cats with broken bones, gashes or open wounds are a common sight. We started taking these **INJURED STREET ANIMALS** for medical help and we could not leave them to their plight.



ANIMAL BIRTH CONTROL



We have converted an old shipping container into a hospital that can perform birth control surgeries for street dogs in the Greater Chennai area.

We aim to establish this facility that can sterilize 1000 animals every month.

The hospital and kennel infrastructure can be shifted to new locations.

A HUMANE SOLUTION TO THE ANIMAL-HUMAN CONFLICTS AND ISSUES

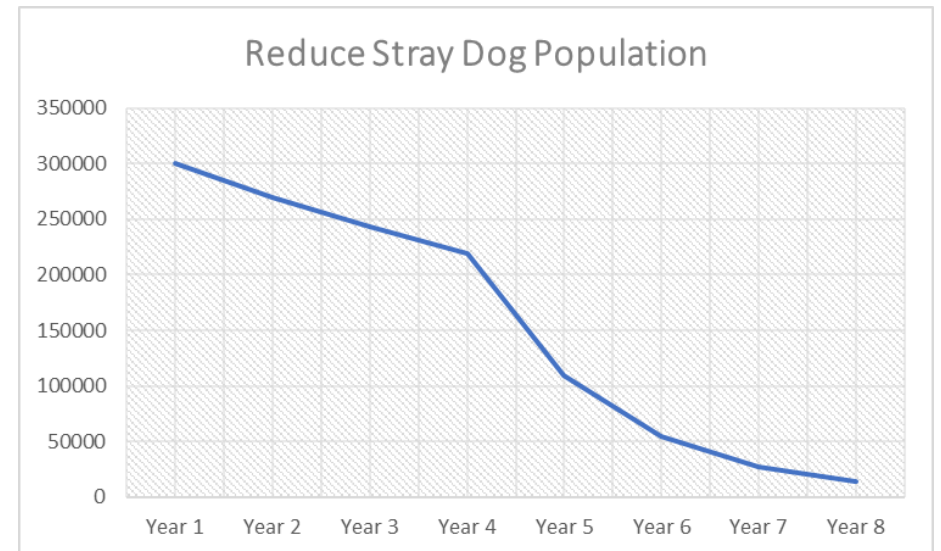


India is facing a civic, environmental and safety issue with an excessive stray dog population. The most humane method to is to prevent unwanted animals from coming into the world. A simple procedure frees the female dog from an endless cycle of bearing children that are unwanted or suffer from diseases, malnutrition.

PAWS will focus on sterilization in a planned and scientific manner leading to reduced dog population and safer communities

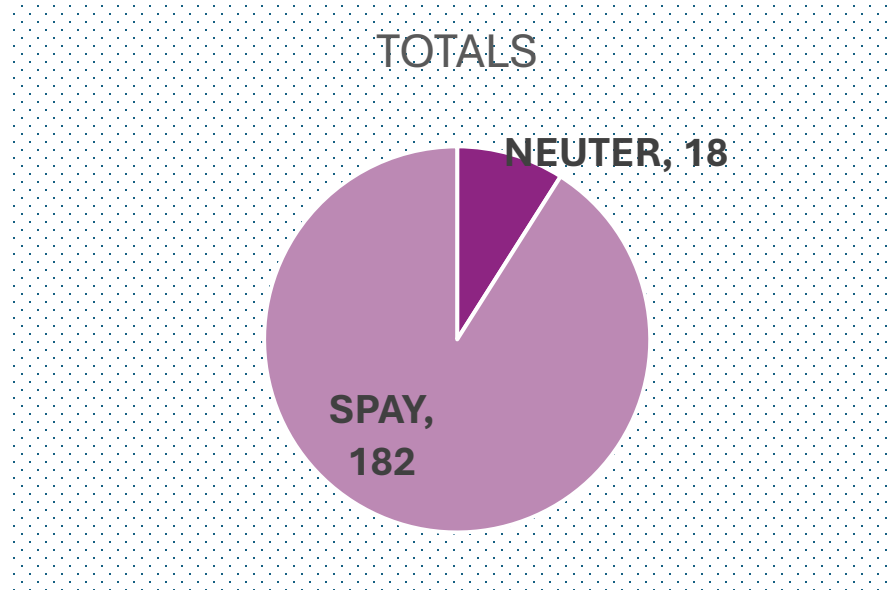
Project ABC from PAWS - is a first-of-its-kind initiative, setting the standard for how India can do an effective Animal Birth Control program that is well designed and scientifically sound.

It is aimed at sterilizing 99% of breeding population of stray dogs in one area paving the way for rabies control and safer communities.

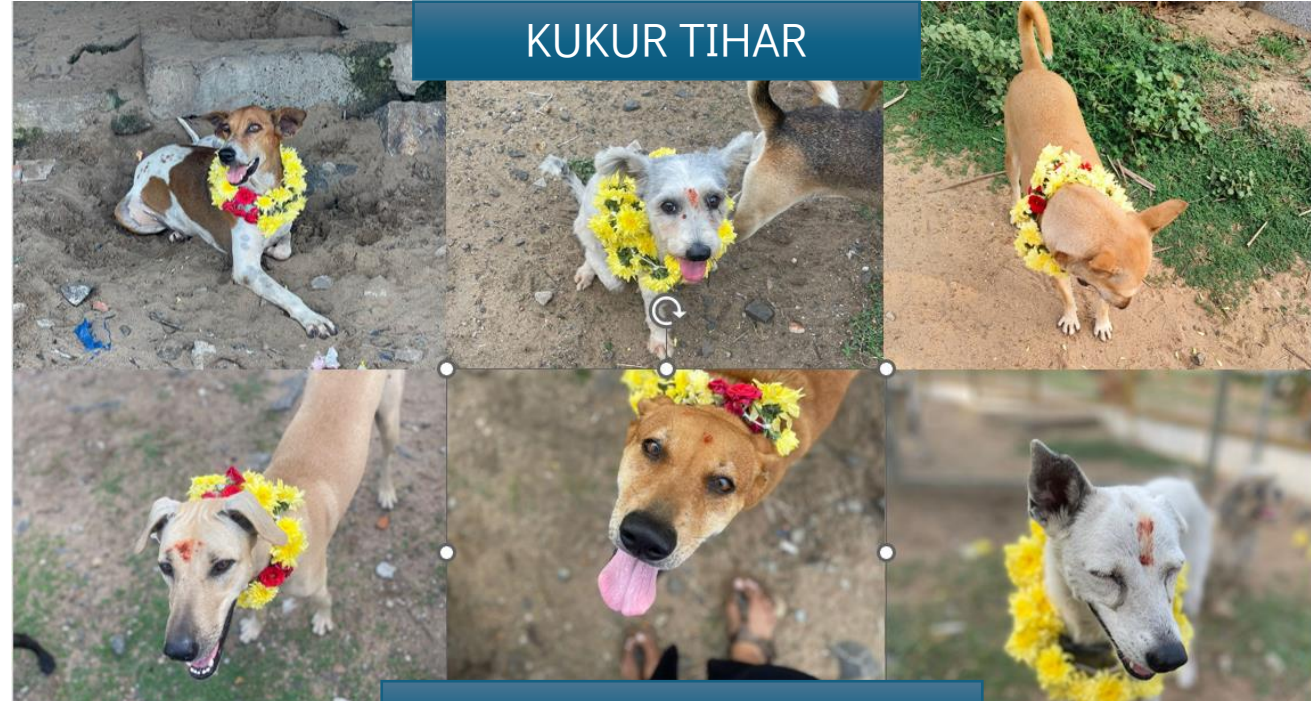
Animals cannot speak for themselves.
