NATIONAL MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE EFFECTIVE 1 MARCH 2025

A. <u>INTRODUCTION AND DEFINITIONS</u>

1. On 4 February 2025, the Minister of Employment and Labour, Nomakhosazana Meth, officially announced the new National Minimum Wage (NMW), which will take effect on 1 March 2025.

B. ADJUSTMENT

2. The NMW Commission has recommended an adjustment to the minimum wage based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) plus an additional 1.5%. With the CPI at 2.9% as of November 2024, this will result in a corresponding increase in the minimum wage.

C. <u>INDUSTRIES AFFECTED</u>

- 3. The increase applies nationwide and will impact various sectors, including, but not limited to:
- 3.1. Domestic workers:
- 3.2. Farmworkers;
- 3.3. Wholesale and retail sector;
- 3.4. Contract cleaning; and
- 3.5. Learnership allowances.

D. <u>UPCOMING MINIMUM WAGE</u>

4. From 1 March 2025, employers are required to adhere to the following minimum rates:
